## REFLECT

Today we celebrate the "birthday of the Church!" Pentecost is described in the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. But before the great driving wind and tongues of fire empowering the Disciples, the Holy Spirit had already arrived. The Gospel for today's Mass during the day is from John 20. Jesus appears to the fearful disciples after his resurrection. He first speaks a message of calm. "Peace be with you." The apostles "rejoiced when they saw the Lord." When the enthusiastic response settles down, Jesus "breathed on them and said to them 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'"

This action is Trinitarian, and it has happened before. If you turn your Bible back to the beginning, you'll read: "The Lord God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so many became a living being" (Genesis 2:7). In the Garden of Eden, we see God's first, original covenant with man. The breath of life signifies that original indwelling of grace, the special state of likeness and friendship with God before the Fall. Here now, in this locked room, the Apostles receive the long-awaited promise: the very breath of God, new life, a new covenant.

In the pairing of these two readings - the Pentecost experience in Acts and the breath of Jesus in John's Gospel - we see that the coming of the Holy Spirit is not only an empowering, it is an indwelling. We have each received the breath of grace in our baptism. It is confirmed, strengthened, and deepened in each reception of the sacraments. If we persevere in virtue, the Spirit of God is alive in us, inspiring our actions of love. This Pentecost Sunday, how is the breath of God alive in you?

## FROM FR. GOLAS

I think spring has finally arrived. In the Parish, there are several projects planned or in the process of being completed. I am very concerned about the leaks in Fr. Kerwan Hall. We have had contractors on the roof assessing the situation. The roof is decades old and in need of replacement. I have asked our maintenance staff to obtain bids for a replacement of the flat roof. The Archdiocese requires three bids for any major projects over \$25,000. We have one bid and are in the process of obtaining two others. Once the three bids are in, I plan to meet with the Facilities Committee of Holy Family Church to consult with them and receive their recommendation. After that, the Executive Committee of the Parish, which is serving as the acting Finance Committee, will need to make their own recommendation so that I can then request permission from the Archbishop to proceed with the project. On another note, the contract for replacing the air conditioning unit for Fr. Kerwan Hall was signed this week and work should begin shortly.

At St Bernard Church, a new amplifier and microphones were installed last week by Unitech for \$8,697.72. After several occasions when the altar microphone failed, I decide to upgrade the system in stages. It is more affordable and provides the improvement we need.

On another note, the Parish merger process continues. Our committees continue their work. The Parish will need to combine the data bases of both Churches and have one census list. From this a combined census with a new envelope system will emerge. I expect this to take place this summer. Any changes will be announced as to lessen the impact. In the meantime, with two separate envelope systems, there have been glitches to overcome. We are working on this for now. I am hoping with one system in the future, there will be a more seamless system. I appreciate your understanding as we go through this process.

## MUSIC TO THE EARS

Beautiful music can be heard every Friday at St. Bernard School, when students take lessons and practice with either the Beginners or Advanced Band. Children in grades 4 - 8 are eligible to take part in the band program, sponsored by Future Musicians of Connecticut. This company sponsors the band program at approximately 50 Catholic schools throughout the state, and students pay a monthly fee to participate. They have the option to choose from a variety of instruments, including the flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, trombone, and drums. In addition to a half hour small group lesson, the aspiring musicians also rehearse with the Advanced Band before school, or with the Beginners Band during recess.

Mr. Richard Shonty is the band director at the school, where he instructs about 20 students every Friday. He travels to several other Catholic schools in the state the rest of the week, and also works with the Jazz Ensemble at Northwest Catholic High School.

He praised the "culture" at SBS, and observed that the children seem very happy here. He also said that they achieve a high level of success in this program. In fact, he said, 7 out of 10 advanced players who auditioned were selected to play at the All-State Music Festival held at Central Connecticut State University earlier this year. The school's bands play at the annual Christmas concert, as well as at a spring concert. This year's spring concert will feature music from Thriller, by Michael Jackson, and Eye of the Tiger. They are also playing music from the Harry Potter movies, which is always fun, says Mr. Shonty.

A summer music program is also offered at the school, with weekly lessons for those who are interested.

This annual event is always a wonderful day, enjoyed by all!



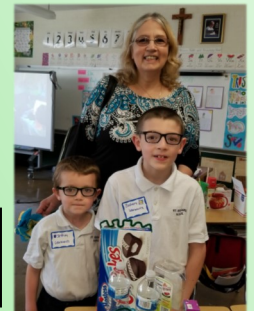

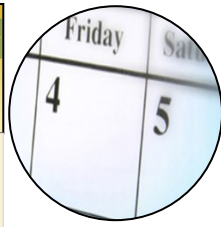

### WORLDWIDE MARRIAGE ENCOUNTER

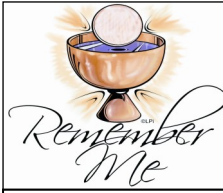
