OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST,
KING OF THE UNIVERSE



REFLECT

If you brought your child to the restroom during the Liturgy of the Word, you might walk away with one of two interpretations of Jesus as King. The first and second readings are bold and victorious. We see Christ coming on the clouds for the final judgment of heaven and earth. The Gospel sets a very different tone. Jesus is under arrest and facing death before Pontius Pilate. We know how this story will end. So if Christ is King, what does it mean? Is he a glorious conqueror or a suffering servant?

"My kingdom does not belong to this world." Here is the heart of Jesus' reign. He is a king -- and his "subjects" are alive and well on earth -- but, ultimately, Jesus' kingdom transcends our earthly concepts of power. Jesus faced down the temptation of a solely earthly kingship. At the close of his 40 days in the desert, the devil offered him the kingdoms of the world. Jesus only had to sacrifice his heavenly values and worship Satan. The same temptations to distort the kingship of Christ are present to us today. Jesus' invitation also endures. "Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice." It is important for us to belong to the full truth of Christ's kingdom.

First, our own hearts must be transformed. Our own rebellions in favor of selfishness and against holiness must be conquered by God's grace. Second, we must work to transform the world as best we can in our own corner of it. Like Jesus shows us by his life and death, this doesn't mean domination. It means service, sacrifice, respect, and love. Our lives must "testify to the truth" of Jesus Christ, who lays down his life for his people. That is the true beauty of Christ the King!

FROM FR. GOLAS,

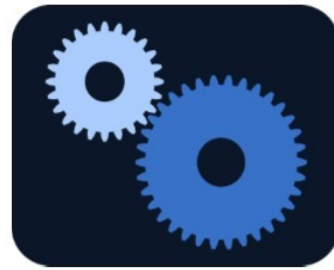
The winter policy for St. Jeanne Jugan Parish - Holy Family Church and St. Bernard Church will be in effect for daily Masses Monday – Friday **beginning December 3rd**. The policy states that when Enfield Public Schools cancel or delay school on that day, the daily 7:30 am Mass at St. Bernard Church and the daily 9 am Mass at Holy Family Church will be cancelled for that day. The policy is for the safety of all. The intentions for the Masses will be rescheduled at a mutually agreeable time.

I would like to announce a change in the hours for Friday Eucharistic Adoration. **Beginning on December 7th**, the period of Adoration after the 9 am Mass at Holy Family Church will conclude with Benediction at noon. It has been a challenge to maintain the minimum two persons per hour to be present in church for the Adoration. I commend those faithful individuals who have extended their hours to honor the Lord present in the Eucharist. The regularly scheduled Holy Hour at St. Bernard Church every first Friday at 3 pm in the chapel will continue. This hour includes Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, evening prayer, and Benediction. This tradition of Eucharistic Adoration is another way the Lord is present to us in our lives. These changes are made with respect to those who are involved in these prayer services.

SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION (December 8, 2018)

This year, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception falls on a Saturday. This is a holy day of obligation, and since it is the patronal feast of the United States, is not abrogated when it falls on a Saturday. Catholics have two obligations to fulfill on this weekend - the holy day and Sunday. Both obligations can be fulfilled on Saturday, just not at the same Mass. Using the chart below, **one blue obligation and one violet obligation must be fulfilled separately.** For a Saturday evening Mass, either obligation can be fulfilled, regardless of the liturgical celebration.
