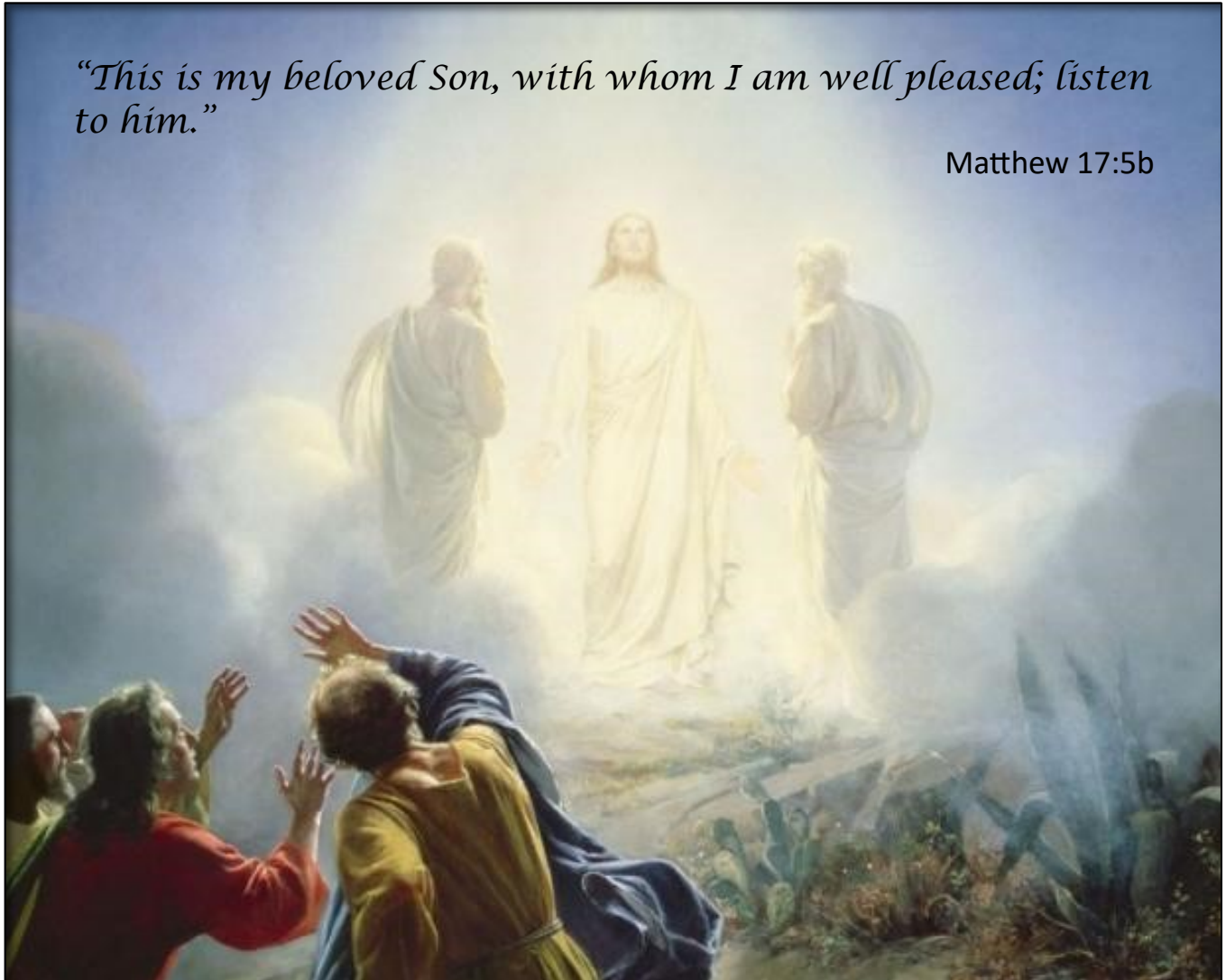

FROM FR. GOLAS:

Fr. Lee Havey C.P., a Passionist priest from St. Ann Monastery in Scranton, PA, will be joining us for a parish mission.

Fr. Lee was born in Scranton, PA and grew up in Waverly, PA. He graduated high school and college from The Lawrenceville School and Lehigh University respectively. Fr. Lee worked in international business and diplomatic circles focusing on ASEAN (the Association of Southeast Asian Nations) prior to religious life and the priesthood.

He professed his first vows as a Passionist on September 3rd, 2000. Following studies at various locations within the Passionist formation program and theological work at Catholic Theological Union (CTU) in Chicago, Fr. Lee graduated with a Master of Divinity degree and was ordained to the priesthood on June 6th, 2004. Some of Fr. Lee's previous ministerial assignments include: St. Ann's Basilica Parish, Scranton, PA; the Passionist Volunteer Outreach, Preston County, W.VA; St. Elizabeth's Medical Center, Brighton, MA; St. Paul of the Cross Retreat Center, Detroit, MI; and Our Lady of Florida Spiritual Center, N. Palm Beach, FL.

During the past 15 years of ordained life, Fr. Lee has been assigned to retreat house ministry at the Bishop Molloy Passionist Retreat House; and parochial ministry at the Immaculate Conception Parish, both in Jamaica, NY. Fr. Lee also served the Passionist community as Director of Vocations for the SPC province. Currently, he leads parish missions, Eucharistic devotions, novenas, and retreats domestically and internationally. He resides with the local Passionist community within St. Ann's Monastery, Scranton, PA.

Please reserve the dates of Sunday March 22nd - Wednesday March 25th. Fr. Havey's talks will be held at 7 pm on Sunday and Monday at Holy Family Church and Tuesday and Wednesday at St. Bernard Church. The theme of the parish mission is "*Discovering Holiness in the Stories of Life*". Fr. Havey will be available during the day for confession or a private conference.

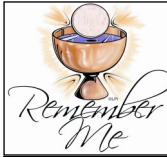


CONFESSION DURING LENT
