



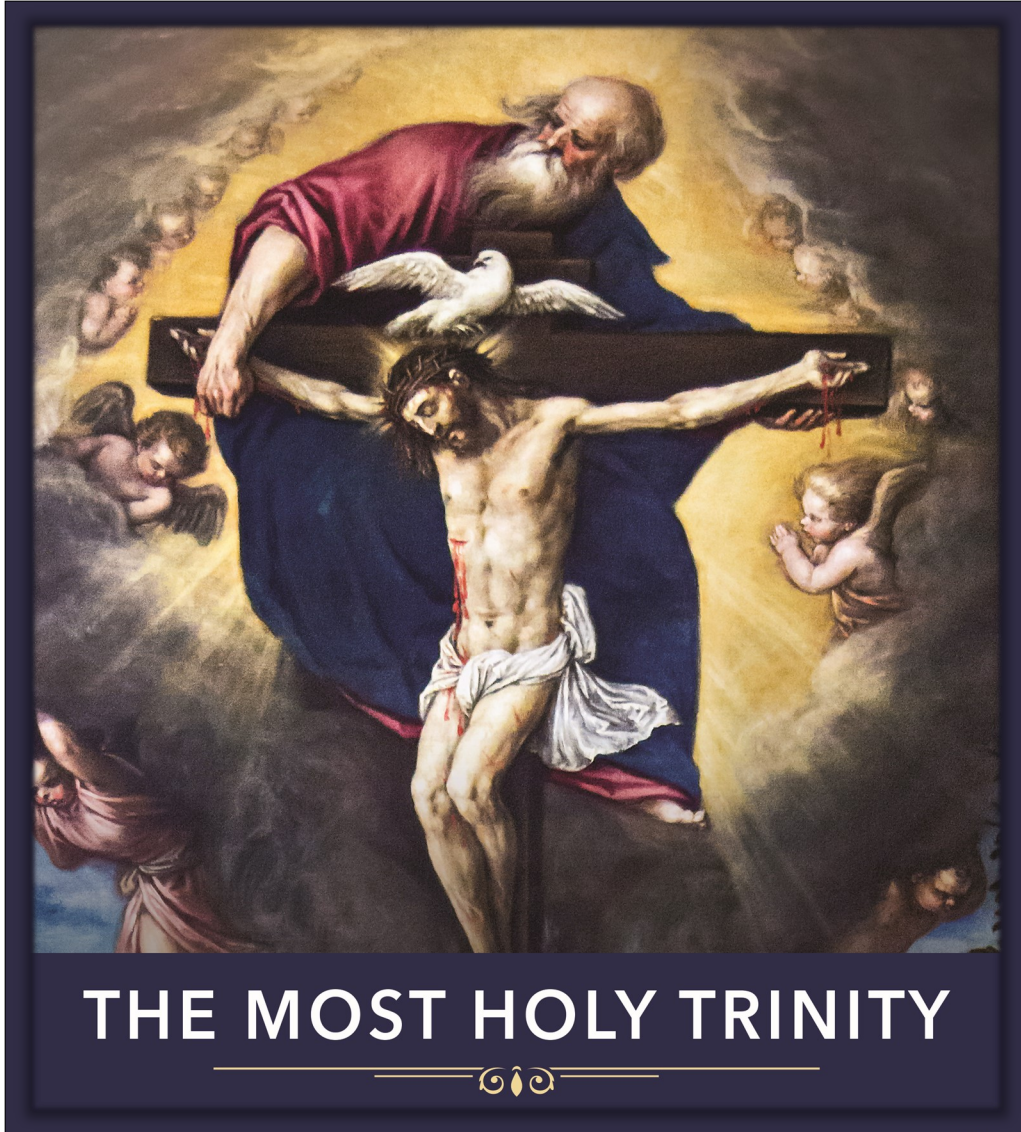

REFLECT

A well-choreographed dance can be truly inspirational. Each movement and step are interconnected, each contributing a piece of the unfolding artistic story. The beholder is caught up in the rhythms, music, and gestures, realizing that none are dispensable and all are necessary. The same is true of the Divine Dance of the Trinity. Each Person plays a part, using unique gestures and movements that are connected to the other Divine Partners. They tell a story of love. Every movement and step is born of love and flows on into eternity. The Divine Dance never ends.

God the Creator powerfully, yet with gentle love, leads. Creating and recreating, birthing and sustaining, He dances with the compassionate incarnate Son, guided by the breath of the Holy Spirit. They are three distinct Persons but move as One. On one hand, the cascading flow of their Presence appears motionless, yet on the other, flows and moves with effortless attention. They share one heart, one goal, and one purpose and invite all of creation to join in their dance, their joy.

The energy of the Trinity flows through all created things. It is a dance of the heart, not of the mind. It has to be experienced, not dissected, and contemplated, not understood. We stand in awe of the Divine Dance and find ourselves watching in amazement all that God creates and sustains. The dance continues in the majesty of a mountain, the power and wonder of an ocean, and the vastness of the universe. It moves in the cry of a newborn infant and in the soul of one who has been forgiven. It flows in the cry for justice and in the wounds of the oppressed. It circles through the changing of seasons, the cycles of birth and death, and the wisdom that one acquires when they love God.

The Dance never ends. Its movements and rhythms go on forever. The Trinitarian Dance sustains all things, endures all things, and brings hope. You are invited to dance. Don't just watch as if you were simply a spectator. Join in the dance and move as they move.

- **Marriage Encounter** is a weekend retreat freeing married couples from distractions so they focus on their marriage. Marriage Encounter is considered the first marriage enrichment program offered to married couples originally presented in Barcelona by Fr. Gabriel Calvo in 1962. The decades of trial and error has made Marriage Encounter the premiere Catholic couples retreat worldwide.
- **Retrouvaille** is for couples considering separation, separated, or divorced wanting to repair their marriage by reviving their relationship. Retrouvaille is a three-phase program with each phase offering opportunities to heal your marriage.

MIRACLE APPROVED! FATHER MCGIVNEY TO BE BEATIFIED!



Father Michael McGivney (1852-1890)

Pope Francis approved a miracle attributed to the intercession of Fr. Michael J. McGivney Wednesday, paving the way for the beatification of the founder of the Knights of Columbus.

During a May 26th meeting with Cardinal Angelo Becciu, the prefect of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, Pope Francis authorized the congregation to issue a decree recognizing the miracle.

Fr. McGivney founded the Knights of Columbus in 1882. Today it is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization, with nearly two million members in more than a dozen countries.

Born in Waterbury, Connecticut, in 1852, Fr. McGivney played a critical role in the growth of the Church in the United States in the latter part of the 19th century. After his ordination in Baltimore in 1877, he served a largely Irish-American and immigrant community in New Haven.

Amid an anti-Catholic climate, he established the Knights to provide spiritual aid to Catholic men and financial help for families that had lost their breadwinner.

A press release from the Knights of Columbus on May 27th said the miracle recognized by Pope Francis involved an unborn child in the United States who was healed in utero of a life-threatening condition in 2015 after his family prayed to Fr. McGivney.

It added that a date would be set soon for the beatification Mass, which will take place in Connecticut.

Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson said: "Fr. McGivney has inspired generations of Catholic men to roll up their sleeves and put their faith into action. He was decades ahead of his time in giving the laity an important role within the Church. Today, his spirit continues to shape the extraordinary charitable work of Knights as they continue to serve those on the margins of society as he served widows and orphans in the 1880s. Fr. McGivney also remains an important role model for parish priests around the world and left us a transformative legacy of effective cooperation between the laity and clergy."

Fr. McGivney's sainthood cause officially opened in 1997 in the Archdiocese of Hartford, Connecticut. In 2008, Pope Benedict XVI declared the American-born priest a Venerable Servant of God in recognition of his life of heroic virtue.

In 2000, an investigation into a miracle attributed to Fr. McGivney's intercession was completed. But in 2011, the Vatican ruled that the event was not miraculous in nature.

In 2012, another possible miracle was reported and placed under investigation.

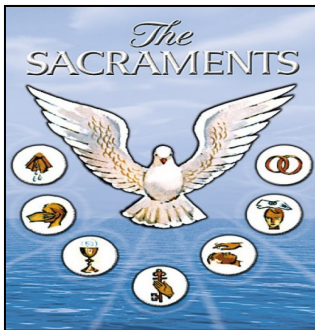
Following his beatification, Fr. McGivney's cause will require one more authenticated miracle before he can be considered for canonization.

REOPENING OF CHURCHES FOR PUBLIC WORSHIP IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

Per a directive from the Archdiocese of Hartford:

As of **Monday, June 8, 2020**, parishes can reopen for the public celebration of **weekday** Masses only, provided that no more than a total of fifty (50) socially distanced persons are present at a given Mass in keeping with the limitation currently set by the civil authorities.

The **dispensation from the Sunday obligation** previously granted to all Catholics of the Archdiocese of Hartford by Archbishop Leonard P. Blair has now been extended through **Sunday, September 6, 2020**. This will remain in effect even when the public celebration of Sunday Mass resumes, hopefully in the very near future.

Live-streamed Masses, both daily and weekend, will continue on our website (sijenfield.org) so that those who cannot attend will be able to participate and remain connected with the parish.

If you decide to attend Mass, please be charitable by protecting others and yourself. Please read and follow the guidelines below.

- If you or someone in your household is ill, especially with fever or flu-like symptoms or conjunctivitis, please do not enter the church.
- At all times, including entering and exiting the church, practice social distancing by staying at least 6 feet from people who do not live in your household.
- You must wear a face mask or cloth face covering.
- Do not shake hands with others.
- Use hand sanitizers.
- Do not congregate to socialize before or after Mass.
