



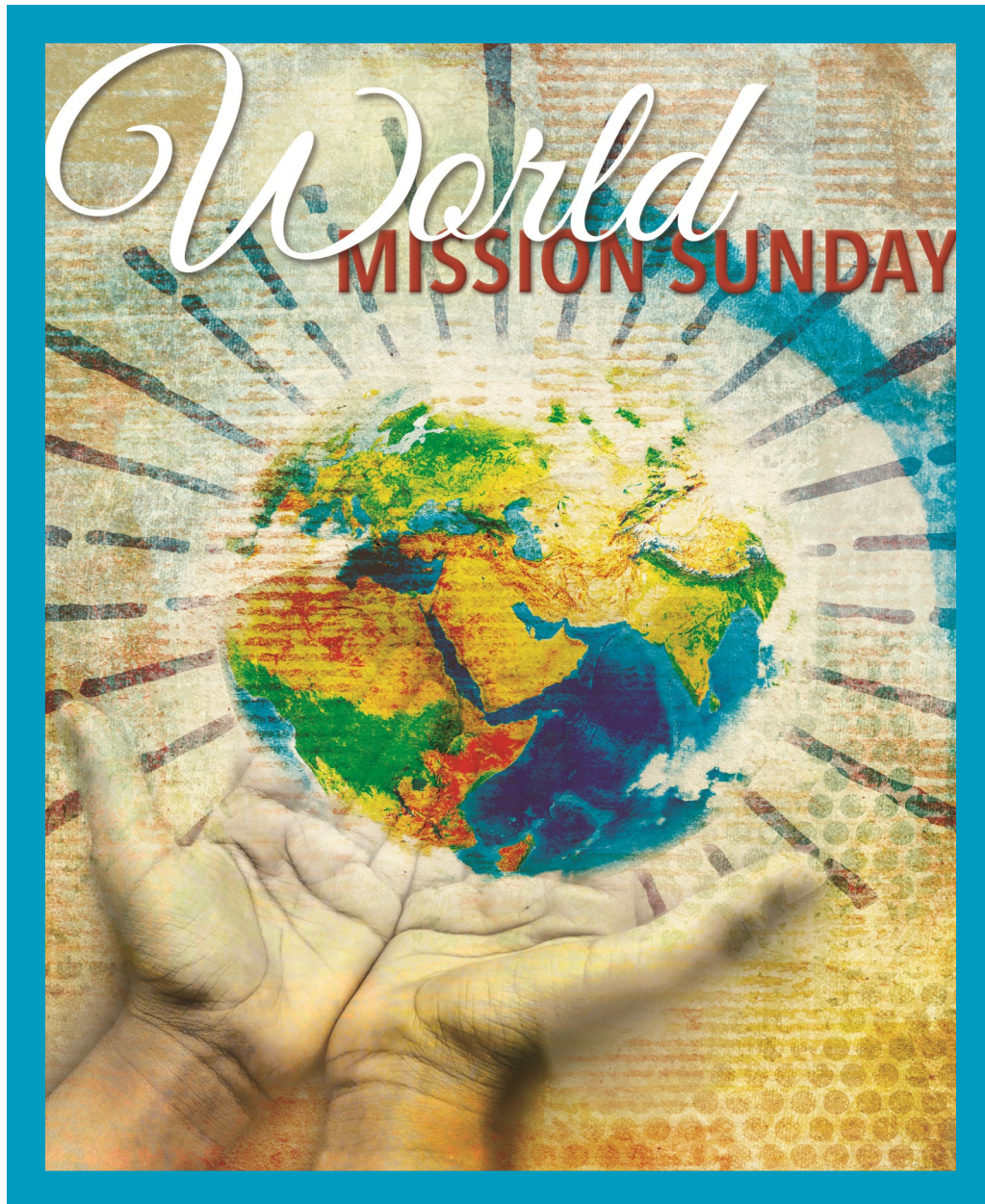

**REFLECT**

Nobody enjoys paying taxes. Despite our displeasure in being forced to do so, we also realize that the monies generated from taxes allows governments to provide essential services for its people. Corruption really gets our goat, however. When we witness malfeasance, overspending, irresponsibility, and dishonesty in governmental spending, the grave injustices make an already unpleasant and arduous task even more difficult. The inappropriate distribution and use of hard-earned monies can leave a person quite angry and disconnected. It's bad enough the government wants something from me, now God does, too?

God is not concerned necessarily with our money, although its proper use does factor into our faith life. As the payment of secular taxes speaks of our allegiance to the government, our return to God speaks of our allegiance to God. All of creation, even the entire universe, is fashioned in the image and likeness of God. What speaks to God and has meaning and relevance to him? All of creation and indeed our very selves! God delights in us and when we present ourselves back to him, he delights even more! As the payment of secular taxes is designed to secure the equitable distribution of goods and services to all people, so is our return of ourselves to God in gratitude meant to advance God's kingdom here on earth.

When our exclusive and sincere allegiance is given to God, God can use us to set things right and straight again. The wounds of sin distort our relationship and disorder our world. By giving ourselves and all of creation back to God in gratitude, we acknowledge the proper Creator and Author of life for who He is and devote our labors exclusively to God's kingdom and the justice, peace, or order God envisions. In giving back to God all that belongs to God, we set the axis of our lives correctly and put our priorities in proper order. All of our relationships, especially with God, our brothers and sisters, and all of creation are perceived more clearly as they really are. **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM 2020-2021**

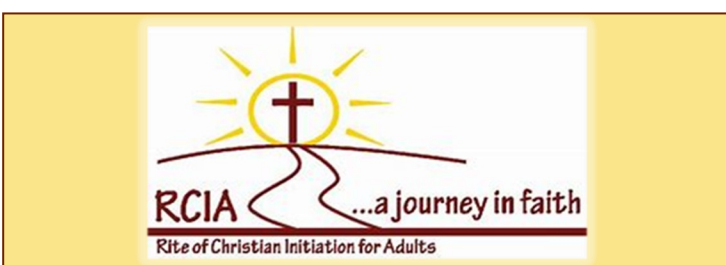
We are asking to partner with you, the parents of our parish children, to come together and teach the children in a team effort. We promise to be there every step of the way and journey with you through our Catholic faith which is rich in Christian teaching, scripture, history, and tradition.

- **Grade K-8** will be homeschooled using the Loyola Press textbook, with catechist involvement and parish support. Monthly K-8 Parent Meetings will be required for only a half-hour on a Thursday evening at Holy Family Church to pick up materials and lesson plans for the coming four weeks of lessons.
- **Grade 2** will only meet at St. Bernard Church the first Saturday of each month for sacramental preparation with their classroom teacher, as well as continued homeschool lessons with parents.
- **Grade 9** will be meeting in person at St. Bernard Church on Sunday evenings starting in October 2020.
- **Grade 10** will follow the schedule that was mailed home to the incoming Confirmation Class of 2020.

**\*\*Please note if you choose not to homeschool your student this current academic year, it will affect your student's grade placement in their next upcoming year in the Religious Education Program.**

## BEATIFICATION OF FATHER MICHAEL MCGIVNEY

Father Michael McGivney, the founder of the Knights of Columbus, will be beatified during a special Mass on **Saturday, October 31, 2020** at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford.

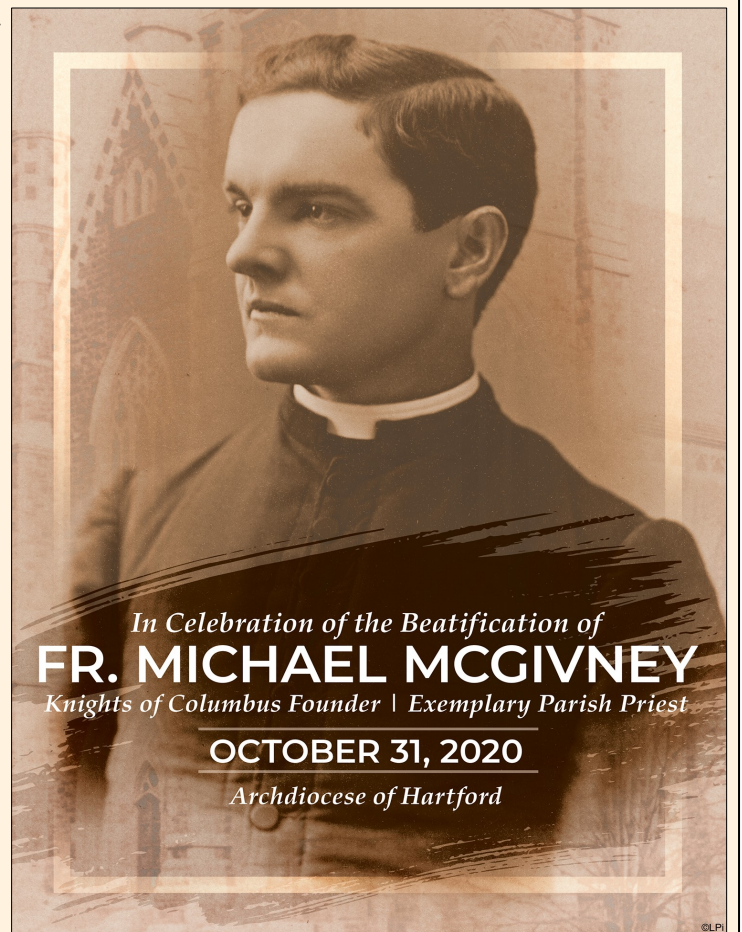
Father McGivney, a priest in the St. Mary's Parish in New Haven, founded the Knights of Columbus 138 years ago to enable Catholic men to support one another and their families with spiritual and temporal needs. On May 27, 2020, Pope Francis approved a decree recognizing a miracle attributed to Father McGivney's intercession, qualifying Father McGivney for beatification.

The miracle recognized by the Vatican occurred in 2015 and involved a baby, still in utero, with a life-threatening condition that, under most circumstances, could have led to an abortion.

That baby, Mikey Schachle, is now 5 years old. His parents, Dan and Michelle Schachle, of Dickson, Tennessee, prayed to Father McGivney to intercede with God to save their son, still in his mother's womb, who was given no hope of surviving a life-threatening case of fetal hydrops.

Father McGivney, who will be the first American parish priest to be beatified and has long been a hero of working-class Catholics, can be viewed as a martyr of a pandemic. When he died of pneumonia complications at age 38 in 1890, it was during an outbreak of influenza known as the Russian flu in Thomaston, Connecticut.

At Father McGivney's beatification Mass, an apostolic letter from the Holy Father will be read along with the bestowing of the title "Blessed" on Father McGivney. This is the step just prior to sainthood. An additional miracle attributed to Father McGivney's intercession will be required for his canonization as a saint.

## UPDATED INFORMATION

### WEEKEND MASSES IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

Parishes are open for the public celebration of **weekend** Masses, provided that no more than a total of 200 socially distanced persons are present at a given Mass in keeping with the updated limitation set by the State of Connecticut, which went into effect on October 8th. All previously set requirements will still be observed during both weekday and weekend Masses. This includes the wearing of masks while in church and the limitation on singing, which may be done by a cantor but will not include participation by the congregation.

***Due to this updated information, it is no longer necessary to register to attend Mass. We thank all those who assisted us to stay in compliance with the previous guidelines by calling to register each week.***

The **dispensation from the Sunday obligation** granted to all Catholics of the Archdiocese of Hartford by Archbishop Leonard P. Blair extends through **Saturday, November 28th**. The elderly, the sick, those who care for someone who is vulnerable, or those who are fearful or anxious are encouraged not to attend or feel obligated to attend at this time.

Live-streamed Masses, both daily and weekend, will continue on our website (sijenfield.org) so that those who cannot attend will be able to participate and remain connected with the parish.

If you decide to attend Mass, please be charitable by protecting others and yourself. Please read and follow the guidelines below.

- **If you or someone in your household is ill, especially with fever or flu-like symptoms or conjunctivitis, please do not enter the church.**
- **At all times, including entering and exiting the church, practice social distancing by staying at least 6 feet from people who do not live in your household.**
- **You must wear a face mask or cloth face covering. The proper way to wear the mask effectively is to have the mask cover both your nose and mouth.**
- **Do not shake hands with others.**
- **Use hand sanitizers.**
- **Do not congregate to socialize before or after Mass.**

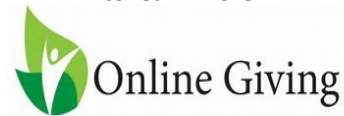

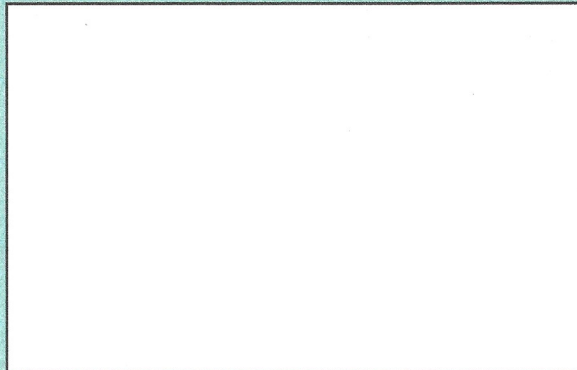
