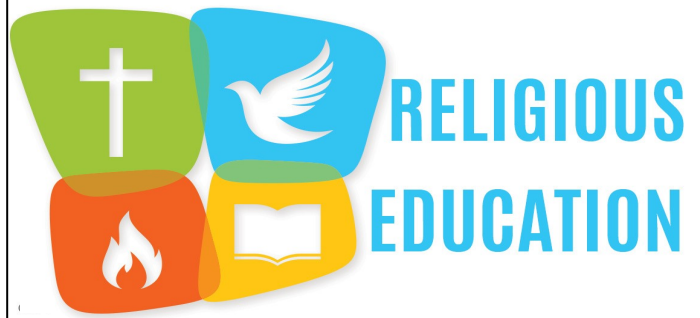

FROM FATHER GOLAS:

Archbishop Blair has announced the time for the closing Mass of Synod 2020. The pandemic delayed by over a year this special event. The closing Mass will be celebrated at the Oakdale Theatre in Wallingford on **Friday, August 13th** at 6:30 pm. As a parish, we have been asked to send a delegation of 28 with our two Synod delegates Karen and Kevin McGuane. I have ordered a bus for our trip which will leave from Holy Family Church parking lot at 4:15 pm. A box lunch will be provided. **For those interested in joining the parish delegation for the closing Mass, please contact Kacey at the Holy Family rectory at admin@sjjenfield.org or by phone at 860-973-1717 ext. 110.** This is the third synod of the Archdiocese and the closing should be a memorable occasion.

For your understanding, a synod is an assembly of various groups representing the faithful of the diocese. Archbishop Blair has convened the Synod 2020 with the theme "Go and Grow". The focus of the synod has been the need for evangelization, which is a vigorous proclamation of the Gospel to draw others to Christ and the Church. Pope Francis has taught that all who are baptized in Christ are missionary disciples who "take our personal encounter with Jesus Christ to others". "Go and Grow 2020" is an important moment for the Church of the Archdiocese of Hartford to renew and revitalize the way we live out our faith at this time. We pray for the Holy Spirit's inspiration for the Synod, the Archdiocese of Hartford and our St. Jeanne Jugan Parish.

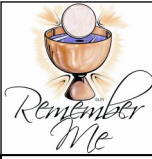

INFORMATION FOR MASSES IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

Given Governor Lamont's declaration that remaining restrictions be lifted, on May 19th our churches reopened to 100% capacity with no need for any specific social distancing. As of June 9th, Archbishop Blair has modified the safety practices regarding COVID-19, stating that **masks will still be required for those who are unvaccinated while in church and optional for those who are fully vaccinated.**

Please also be advised that the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass in person on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is no longer in force as of May 22, 2021. Detailed information can be found below.

UPDATED DISPENSATION

As of Saturday, May 22, 2021, the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass in person on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is no longer in force. Given the reality that the pandemic has not completely subsided, we recognize that some persons may deeply desire to return to Mass in person but are prevented from doing so for legitimate reasons, such as: (1) suffering from serious pre-existing conditions that may make a person more susceptible to falling ill from COVID-19; (2) being ill and homebound or being a caregiver in close contact with someone who is; (3) having tested positive for any contagious disease, including COVID-19; or (4) being in quarantine due to exposure to any contagion or residing with someone who is quarantined. For anyone facing these circumstances, please remember that the Lord will never invite you to do something that poses a danger to oneself or others.

Live-streamed Masses, both daily and weekend, will continue on our website (sijenfield.org) so that those who cannot attend will be able to participate and remain connected with the parish. If you decide to attend Mass, please be charitable by protecting others and yourself.

COVID-19 VACCINE INFORMATION

In accordance with the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Holy See in Rome, the Connecticut Catholic Bishops have issued the following statement regarding the COVID-19 vaccines:
