UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

What has been the most difficult challenge you faced in your life? Many difficult human experiences can “turn up the heat” in our lives, causing us to question the why of things or even fall into despair. Some people just somewhat passively accept what life brings, even death, and chalk difficult experiences up to happening “because they do.” They seemingly endure and move on. Taking life at face value, there really is no ultimate meaning to things. It’s easier to ignore that inner prompting calling us to understand why. It’s there whether we admit it or not. To question or not to question — that is the question! People sometimes give up the God search because it causes too many questions. Once we open the door to the possibility of God’s existence, then all of the awkward, challenging, and tragic pieces of life have to find their place.

It gets messy. But the search is so important to living. We can easily dry up and become arid, abandoning any hope for purpose and meaning because it’s too difficult and non-rational at times. In searching for answers to the how and why of life, human beings also embark on a search for God. When one finally stumbles upon the real living tangible presence of God, then that discovery allows life’s ironies and tensions to be held side by side with the all-encompassing totally unconditional, unmerited love of God! Then when life’s heat gets turned up, difficulties and challenges abound, dryness and heartache become the norm, the soul remains in joyful repose. There is no fear.

The beatitudes celebrate life’s ironies and tensions, holding them all together in the Kingdom of God. Poverty, hunger, weeping, being insulted and hated are not things we would normally associate with being God’s friends. But they are! In fact, those who experience these uncomfortable realities of life are actually better off than those who do not. This is what makes Jesus’ message so intriguing! Don’t give up questioning. Questioning the apparent inequities and polarities of human experience will certainly challenge one’s faith. But it’s the only way to deepen it.

WINTER POLICY

The winter policy for St. Jeanne Jugan Parish is in effect for daily Masses Monday through Friday.

THEME	OBJECT	SCRIPTURE
Making sure our values are right.	Three items and price tags for each.	Luke 6:22-23

DISCUSSION

There is a television game show called "The Price is Right" that has been on the air for fifty years. Perhaps some of you have seen it. On the show, the contestants play various games in which they must guess the correct price of different items. One of the games they play is the price matching game. Here is how it is played: There are several different items and price tags. The contestants have to match the correct price tag with each item.

I thought it might be fun to see how well you might do playing "The Price is Right," so I have brought several items and price tags. We will see if you can match each item with the correct price tag. (Allow some time for the children to match price tags with the items you have brought.) That was fun, wasn't it? As you can see, it isn't always easy to decide what the right price is. You have to have a very good sense of the value of things. That is not only true in playing "The Price Is Right," it is also true in real life.

Many people have some really mixed up values about what is important in life. For example, some people might think that the most important thing in life is to be popular. They will do anything to be popular and they will eventually discover that they have put too high a price tag on popularity.

There are other people who think that being rich is the most important thing in life. They are even willing to lie, cheat, and steal if that is what it takes to get rich. They will discover that if being rich is more important than being honest, then the price tag is way too high.

Jesus did not want us to be confused about what is important in life. One day He taught a lesson to teach what is really important. He taught that devoting your life to seeking wealth, happiness, and popularity would leave you empty.

Well then, what is the most important thing? Jesus taught that the greatest reward comes by following Him and making Him the Lord of your life. But it has a price tag on it. He warned that other people might not like you, they might exclude you from their circle of friends, they might talk about you behind your back. But, don't worry, Jesus said you will have your reward in Heaven. That has the highest price tag of all, but Jesus paid the price!

Dear Jesus, there is no greater thing than knowing and following You. Thank you for paying the price so that those who do follow You will have their reward -- forgiveness for sin and eternal life in Heaven. Amen.

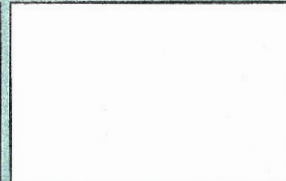

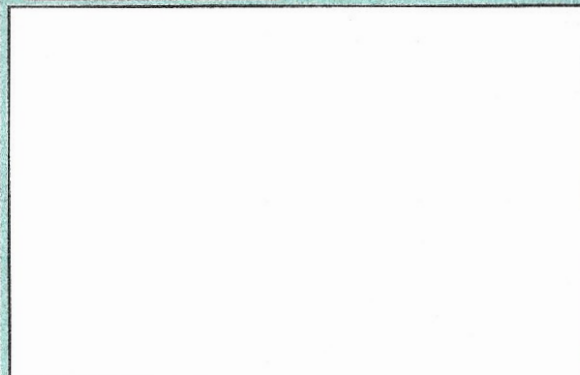

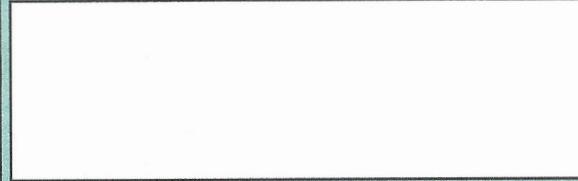
