## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Could it be that God's image has become so soiled and distorted that it is hard for us to see it? Our self-serving agendas have done a great job twisting God's image into what profits us. We want our agenda to be God's agenda and use prayer as the convincing leverage we need. Worse still, our success and egocentric agenda often erases God's image completely, replacing it with our own. St. Oscar Romero instructs us that the Son of Man "dies on the cross to cleanse God's image, which is soiled in today's humanity, a humanity so enslaved, so selfish, so sinful." Striving to preserve control of our destinies at all costs, we fail to see the risen suffering servant, the Christ, standing right beside us.

Jesus, who suffered and died on a cross and was raised from the dead, corrects our soiled image of God. He shows us God as God is, not who we want to make God to be. God is the God of the poor, the weak, and the marginalized. He is the God who tenderly caresses us when we are suffering and hurting, assuring us that all will be safe and well. He is the God of equity, peace, justice, and compassion who wants happiness for each of His children, desiring their wellbeing and success. God goes where men and women are afraid to go, sitting with the lost, the broken, and the sorrowing. St. Oscar Romero challenges us to illuminate with "Christ's light ... even the most hideous caverns of the human person: torture, jail, plunder, want, chronic illness. The oppressed must be saved." The resurrection calls us to be God's microphone, a messenger, and a prophet (St. Oscar Romero).

Using eyes that see beyond the limited constructs and desires of our world, we can see the true and real Jesus standing before us, calling us to transformation and change. Asking us more than once, "do you love Me?" We are beckoned to give an answer. Answering in the affirmative, it is now our task to feed the sheep and the lambs who belong to God. In short, equipped with the power of the resurrection and a corrected image of God our task is to make things better, brighter, holier, more life-giving, and just for all of God's children. Considering our choices, our interactions, our philosophies, and aspirations, how can we do this?

Nothing can take us out of Jesus' hand.	A yo-yo.	John 10:28

## DISCUSSION

Do you have a yo-yo? Do you know how to do any tricks with your yo-yo? I brought a yo-yo this morning so that I could show you how to do a few simple tricks.

The first thing that most people learn how to do is the basic "throw down." I'm sure that all of you can do that. You simply hold your hand out in front of you with the palm up. With a flick of the wrist, throw the yo-yo straight down. When the yo-yo reaches the end of the string, give a little tug and the yo-yo returns to the palm of your hand.

Another easy trick is the "forward pass." It is very similar to the "throw down" except that instead of throwing it down, you throw it out in front of you. When the yo-yo reaches the end of the string, give it a tug back and catch it in the palm of your hand.

Now that you have learned the "throw down" and the "forward pass," you are ready for one of the best yo-yo tricks of all. It is called the "sleeper." It starts out just like the "throw down." Throw the yo-yo down with a flick of the wrist, but when it gets to the end of the string, don't pull it back immediately. You will see that the yo-yo stays down at the end of the string and spins. When you are ready, just a slight tug pulls it right back up into the palm of your hand.

The final trick I want to show you is called "around the world." It starts out like the "forward pass," but when the yo-yo gets to the end of the string, you don't pull it back. Instead, you swing it over your shoulder around in a circle and then when it gets back to the starting place, you jerk the string and bring the yo-yo back home. This one is a little bit more difficult and sometimes I mess up. Ready? Here goes! Oh wow! I really messed up on that one, didn't I? Well, no problem. I'll just pick up my yo-yo, rewind it, and then I'll be ready to go again.

Did you notice that every one of these tricks started and ended exactly the same way? Each trick began and ended with the yo-yo right here -- in the palm of my hand. I think that can help us to learn something about Jesus.

One day, some people asked Jesus to tell them plainly if He was the Christ. He answered them saying, "I told you, but you did not believe Me because you are not my sheep. My sheep listen to my voice and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish; no one can snatch them out of My hand."

When you give your heart to Jesus and place your life in His hands, you have His promise that you are safe and that nothing can snatch you from His hand. Oh, you may have your "ups and downs." You may even stray away at times, but just a little tug will pull you right back into His hand. Even if you really mess up, like I did on the "around the world" trick, He picks you up and places you right back where you belong -- in the palm of His hand. What a wonderful promise! Jesus has you in the palm of His hand and nothing can take you from His hand!

*Father, we are thankful that Jesus holds us safely in the palm of His hand and that nothing can snatch us from His hand. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.*

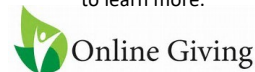
