## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Unity and diversity can exist together. Our western minds have a grave difficulty seeing unity without conformity. We tend to believe that unless everyone believes the same thing, assents to the same body of truths, styles, and opinions, unity is not possible. Jesus, in today's Gospel, expresses a tenderness and an intimacy that the disciples actually can witness. This same tenderness and love are also reflected in His desire for unity and oneness. Jesus passionately wants all to be one. It is very clear that the success of Jesus' mission and the advance of the Gospel rises or falls with whether this unity is achieved. And it is a unity that is achieved around a person and not particulars.

Our church is extremely divided. These divisions all center on various theologies, philosophies, structures, and styles. We allow these particular concerns and interpretations, valid as many can be, to drive wedges between us and put us at odds with each other. They enrage us and cause us to lash out at other members of the Body of Christ. Differences are bound to exist in any group. We are unique and diverse people. Staunchly clinging to particular agendas and ideologies while waving the "we're right, you're wrong" banner as we forge ahead in battle does little to advance the real mission of Christ. We are perceived as weak, fractioned, self-focused and serving, and lacking empathy and love. How can the work of salvation be accomplished like this? We sacrifice our credibility. For what?

"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end." These words describe exactly who the glorified Christ really is. Jesus wants us to see this glory! Believe this! This is the unifying principle that draws the Body of Christ together as one, not our particular preferences of worship! We give too much power to our preferences, and all too easily forget that the real mission of Christ is much more than that! If we can work at truly loving each other as members of Christ's Body despite the differences that can so quickly divide us, then maybe we'll be a bit more convincing to those who do not believe. The Risen Christ comes to us through the Eucharist. It doesn't matter where or how. Gather wherever you can and receive. We cannot substitute Jesus' passion with our own. We are one.

# OTHER ANNOUNCEMENTS

### \*\*NOTE #1 FROM FR. GOLAS\*\*

I wanted to inform you of a major project that will be taking place in Fr. Kerwan Hall this summer. Beginning June 1st, licensed contractors will be removing the asbestos floor tiles from the hall. It should take approximately one month to complete, as the planned work is to be done in three stages. The first stage is to remove the tiles from the hallway by the Religious Education office and Music room (classrooms 1&2 and 3), which requires that section of the building to be closed off from use. The entrance to that section will be closed during Stage 1. Stage 2 will encompass half of Fr. Kerwan Hall, including the kitchen and classrooms 4&5. Stage 3 will be the remainder of Fr. Kerwan Hall. This plan is designed to keep some access through the hall and to the restrooms. After Stage 1 is completed, including air tests verifying that the hall is safe to be used, this section will be open for use even without the final flooring installed. There will, however, be restricted access to some of the facilities with the new flooring being installed in July. I will keep you informed of the progress of the project, as well as, any changes to the patterns of access. I ask for your cooperation and patience as this project is being undertaken to enhance Fr. Kerwan Hall for all. Thank you!

### \*\*NOTE #2 FROM FR. GOLAS\*\*

I want to inform you of the new Mass Schedule that will go into effect on **July 1st, 2022**.

This schedule is based on the view that the parish has two full time priests assigned to it. There are many changes, including a decreasing number of Masses that will be offered. Four of the churches will be used for Masses as the merger process begins, with Fr. Villa saying the Masses at St. Martha Church.

I hope we keep in sight the good of the parish as a whole and the needs of the Catholic community of Enfield. Fr. Mathew and I will do our best to serve the pastoral needs of our parishioners. Through this change, we will need your cooperation and understanding. Working together with God's help, we can be a spirit and faith-filled community - like the ones we have been hearing about in our readings from Acts during this Easter season.

## St. Bernard School & Little Angels Pre-School



### THEME

In unity we show God's love to the world.

### OBJECT

None.

### SCRIPTURE

John 17:20-26

### DISCUSSION

I'm so glad to have all of you here today. Each of you brings something different that adds to our time together. (Name some things that stand out about individual children, and how they add to the group. Invite kids to share about others, as well, making sure one strength of each child is shared.) We'll learn from the Bible today that when we're all united, that's one way we show God's love to the world. So let's do something to help us think about that.

Have children gather in a circle and hold hands. Have them stand and walk in their circle. Invite them to discuss ways the circle can represent believers being united in Jesus.

We're all different, but God works through all of us, and when we are all excited and working toward the goal of loving others together as one big circle, others will see God's love and want to join in. In the Bible, Jesus prayed for His friends that they would be united with Him and with one another. (Invite kids to share what they think that means.) It means we all work together to follow Him and love others. One way we can do that is to pray together like Jesus prayed. Still holding hands, lead kids in a brief prayer. Allow kids to say prayers, if they want to. It also means we celebrate Jesus together! We tell others about Him and we worship Him!

Invite kids to brainstorm what they do when they're really excited about something. Challenge the children to perform some of these actions without letting go of one another's hands. If time allows, invite them to sing a verse of a worship song they're all familiar with and celebrate Jesus together while still holding hands.

Being united in Jesus means we also pay attention to everyone in Jesus' family, like the people to our left and our right. We stop and comfort them when they're down. We're helpful and encouraging.

While still holding hands, have kids turn and speak encouraging or comforting words to their left and their right. If time allows, invite children to share some other ways they think people can be united in showing Jesus' love, and challenge them to perform an action to demonstrate that idea.

Today we've practiced being one in Jesus, and we can be one in Jesus in our lives, too. We don't have to hold hands. If we all love Jesus and love others, this is a way to show God's love to the world together.

*God, help us to be united in Jesus so others can see Your love. In Jesus' name, amen.*
