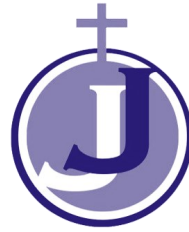

UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Even though Pentecost is rightly celebrated in late spring, the robust experience of a New England fall can provide a profound metaphor for reflection. A full expression of fall colors is beautiful to behold. But, with all of its majesty and beauty, the observer knows the experience of death is soon to come. Creation will be dark and barren for a while. Pentecost cannot be separated from the cross. Before God's transformative, life-giving power can bear fruit, we must first die.

Pentecost is all about leaving the lifeless dead wood behind and allowing God, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to create something new. These Pentecost creations happen repeatedly over and over again. The birthing process of the Church is ongoing. God is always bringing life out of death and creating something where there was once nothing. That is why the fall is such an apropos metaphorical season for Pentecost. In order to really receive the gift of the Holy Spirit we have to die to what we once knew and what no longer works.

When fire and wind find their fullest expression, they are in no way gentle nor kind. They have the potential to level anything in their paths. We are experiencing great turmoil in our world, nation, and our Church. Whether the result of circumstance or the work of the Holy Spirit, much of what we knew to be normal and constant is changing. Common systems and institutional structures that may have worked for a time no longer do. When the old and familiar need to be left behind, God creates something new. Change and disorder do not need to be our enemies. They always bring opportunities for something exciting and new. What we need is untiring faith, firm hope, and perfect love.

What we need is for the Holy Spirit to enlighten us to see what is important and what we must do. *"O Holy Spirit, descend plentifully into my heart. Enlighten the dark corners of this neglected dwelling and scatter there Thy cheerful beams."* (St. Augustine) If we experience joy, even in the midst of turbulence, then we will know we are exactly where God needs us to be. If not, then perhaps there is a lesson in the decaying leaves that graciously descend to the ground on a crisp fall day.

NOTE #1 FROM FR. GOLAS

I wanted to inform you of a major project that will be taking place in Fr. Kerwan Hall this summer. Beginning June 1st, licensed contractors will be removing the asbestos floor tiles from the hall. It should take approximately one month to complete, as the planned work is to be done in three stages. The first stage is to remove the tiles from the hallway by the Religious Education office and Music room (classrooms 1&2 and 3), which requires that section of the building to be closed off from use. The entrance to that section will be closed during Stage 1. Stage 2 will encompass half of Fr. Kerwan Hall, including the kitchen and classrooms 4&5. Stage 3 will be the remainder of Fr. Kerwan Hall. This plan is designed to keep some access through the hall and to the restrooms. After Stage 1 is completed, including air tests verifying that the hall is safe to be used, this section will be open for use even without the final flooring installed. There will, however, be restricted access to some of the facilities with the new flooring being installed in July. I will keep you informed of the progress of the project, as well as, any changes to the patterns of access. I ask for your cooperation and patience as this project is being undertaken to enhance Fr. Kerwan Hall for all. Thank you!

NOTE #2 FROM FR. GOLAS

I want to inform you of the new Mass Schedule that will go into effect on **July 1st, 2022.**

This schedule is based on the view that the parish has two full time priests assigned to it. There are many changes, including a decreasing number of Masses that will be offered. Four of the churches will be used for Masses as the merger process begins, with Fr. Villa saying the Masses at St. Martha Church.

I hope we keep in sight the good of the parish as a whole and the needs of the Catholic community of Enfield. Fr. Mathew and I will do our best to serve the pastoral needs of our parishioners. Through this change, we will need your cooperation and understanding. Working together with God's help, we can be a spirit and faith-filled community - like the ones we have been hearing about in our readings from Acts during this Easter season.

DISCUSSION

Some of you may have a portable music player. If you do, then you know that before it can make music, it must have batteries in it. If the player has built-in batteries they must be charged. The batteries give the player the power that it needs to be able to play. Without batteries, the player can do nothing. Without batteries, it has no power to do what it was created to do.

Before Jesus returned to heaven to be with His Father, He told His disciples that they would do even greater things than He had done when He was on earth. Now Jesus did some pretty great things, didn't He? He healed the sick. He turned water into wine. He made the blind to see and the lame to walk. Where were the disciples going to get the power to do such great things? Jesus promised them that He would ask the Father to send the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit would give them the power to do great and mighty things.

It happened just as Jesus said it would. On the day which is called Pentecost, the disciples were all together in one place. The Bible tells us that there was a sound from Heaven like a mighty rushing wind and it filled the place where the disciples were gathered. Then, there were flames of fire that appeared and rested upon each of them. When these things happened, the disciples were filled with power and began to preach and teach about Jesus. They were able to do things that they had never done before because of the power of the Holy Spirit in them.

Did you know that you and I have that very same power available to us today? The Bible says that "all who are led by the Spirit are children of God." We who are the children of God have the power to do great and mighty things, not in our own strength, but through the power of the Holy Spirit that is within us.

Dear Father, we pray that we will be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit just as the disciples were on the day of Pentecost. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

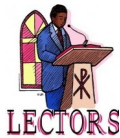

Update on Abortion Laws in CT:

- Bill HB 5414 has **passed** in CT, making it the first sanctuary state for abortionists and women seeking an abortion. They can come from states that have restrictions on abortions and procure or perform an abortion in CT without question.
- Bill SB 88 Assisted Suicide **failed** again.
- Bill HB 5261 has **passed** in CT allowing LPNs and Midwives to perform abortions, as well as, doctors.
- The Constitutional amendment is still on the table but needs a 2/3's majority vote in CT Congress as well as a public vote.
- CT is one of only a few states that allow a minor girl to procure an abortion without parental notification and does NOT have a ban on the murderous "partial birth abortion" even though abortion is banned after viability (very vague description of when that occurs.)

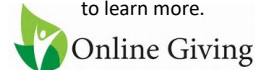

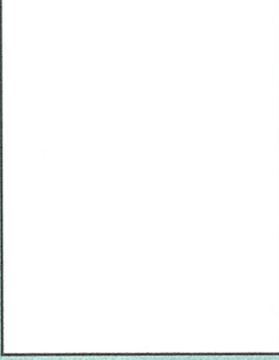
