## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Jesus went to those most in need. He forgave the sinner, ate with the outcast, defended, and fed those who were poor and hungry. He worked for true justice, risked being unpopular, willingly accepted suffering and death, and always stayed connected with his Abba, Father. Jesus also consistently reminded folks that God's compassion, love, and mercy trump everything, even the law. This is the Christ that the Eucharist calls us to be. As we look around our churches, our towns and cities, and our world, there are many people who need to see the face and body of Christ. Some of those most in need may be right within our families. But it is always in the poorest of the poor and those most vulnerable that we find the greatest need. There are many who cannot function on their own. When the gift of the Eucharistic Christ takes root in our hearts, we can more readily see the face of Christ in others.

Many people are vulnerable. Highest on that list are the homeless. They show us the face of Christ. Whatever the cause, to have no place to go and no place to call home takes a toll on the human spirit. For Jesus when there were hungry people, they were fed. God asks us to do the same ... feed people. There are many who are hungry physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Gifted by the Eucharistic presence of Christ, we can bring them Christ. Who are the hungry around us and how can we feed them?

When someone is hurting, you comfort them. When someone is hungry, you feed them. When someone needs clothes, you provide them. When someone is cold, you warm them. When someone is in prison, you visit them. With over a million people who are homeless and over a quarter of them children, it is important to ask the question, "why?" and strategize for ways to lessen or alleviate the problem. Nevertheless, we are not off the hook for responding to the immediate needs that present themselves at our doors. Whether a person's current station in life is self-imposed or the result of being victimized, they are sacred vessels. We cannot lock the door and send them away and still believe we bear the Eucharistic presence of Christ. It doesn't work like that.

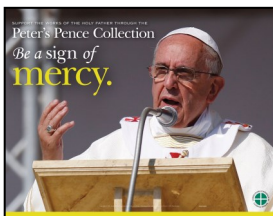

# NOTES FROM FR. GOLAS

## \*\*CONSTRUCTION AT HOLY FAMILY CHURCH\*\*

I wanted to inform you of a major project that will be taking place in Fr. Kerwan Hall this summer. Beginning June 1st, licensed contractors will be removing the asbestos floor tiles from the hall. It should take approximately one month to complete, as the planned work is to be done in three stages. The first stage is to remove the tiles from the hallway by the Religious Education office and Music room (classrooms 1&2 and 3), which requires that section of the building to be closed off from use. The entrance to that section will be closed during Stage 1. Stage 2 will encompass half of Fr. Kerwan Hall, including the kitchen and classrooms 4&5. Stage 3 will be the remainder of Fr. Kerwan Hall. This plan is designed to keep some access through the hall and to the restrooms. After Stage 1 is completed, including air tests verifying that the hall is safe to be used, this section will be open for use even without the final flooring installed. There will, however, be restricted access to some of the facilities with the new flooring being installed in July. I will keep you informed of the progress of the project, as well as, any changes to the patterns of access. I ask for your cooperation and patience as this project is being undertaken to enhance Fr. Kerwan Hall for all. Thank you!

I received notice from Archbishop Blair that Fr. Joseph MacNeill is being assigned as Parochial Vicar to St. Jeanne Jugan Parish, St. Martha Parish and St. Raymond Parish in Enfield from June 27, 2022 through September 18, 2022.

Fr. MacNeill was ordained in 2021 at the Cathedral of St. Joseph. Fr. Mathew and I appreciate the assistance of another priest at this time. We look forward to extending a welcome to Fr. MacNeill to our parish communities that are in the process of being merged.

## \*\*NEW MASS SCHEDULE\*\*

I want to inform you of the new Mass Schedule that will go into effect on **July 1st, 2022**.

This schedule is based on the view that the parish has two full time priests assigned to it. There are many changes, including a decreasing number of Masses that will be offered. Four of the churches will be used for Masses as the merger process begins, with Fr. Villa saying the Masses at St. Martha Church.

I hope we keep in sight the good of the parish as a whole and the needs of the Catholic community of Enfield. Fr. Mathew and I will do our best to serve the pastoral needs of our parishioners. Through this change, we will need your cooperation and understanding. Working together with God's help, we can be a spirit and faith-filled community - like the ones we have been hearing about in our readings from Acts during this Easter season. *May God Bless!*

## DISCUSSION

Do you like to go out to eat? If I were to ask you to name your favorite place to go out to eat, I might get a lot of different answers. If I were to ask you where you think the most popular restaurant in the entire world is, what would your answer be? (Allow the children to tell you where they think it is.) Well, my guess would be that the most popular restaurant in the entire world is McDonald's. (Hold up your McDonald's item.)

I have some very interesting facts about McDonald's to share with you this morning. Did you know that there are over 30,000 McDonald's restaurants in over 120 countries? Did you know that McDonald's uses over three million pounds of potatoes a day? That's a lot of fries! Did you know that McDonald's serves over 45 million people each day!

What is it that makes McDonald's so popular? Is it that they serve the best food in the world? I don't think so. I think that much of McDonald's popularity can be summed up in these two little words -- "supersize it." You can go into McDonald's and order a cheeseburger, regular fries, and a medium drink for a very reasonable price. Or, you can "supersize it" and you get TWO cheeseburgers, large fries, and a large drink for only a few cents more! What a deal! No wonder so many people eat at McDonald's.

Now, you might think that McDonald's was the first to super size a meal, but not so! Let me tell you about a time when Jesus "supersized" a meal.

One day Jesus was teaching a group of over five thousand people. When it came time to eat, Jesus' disciples wanted Him to send the people away, because there was not enough food for them. Jesus asked them how much food there was and they told Him there were only five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus took the bread and fish, blessed it, and gave it to the disciples to pass out to the people. The Bible says that all of the people ate and were satisfied. When they were through, they gathered up twelve baskets full of "leftovers." Now, that's what I call supersizing it!

We have been taught that "bigger is better," but that isn't always true. In fact, "little is much when God is in it."

### Update on Abortion Laws in CT:

- Bill HB 5414 has **passed** in CT, making it the first sanctuary state for abortionists and women seeking an abortion. They can come from states that have restrictions on abortions and procure or perform an abortion in CT without question.
- Bill SB 88 Assisted Suicide **failed** again.
- Bill HB 5261 has **passed** in CT allowing LPNs and Midwives to perform abortions, as well as, doctors.
- The Constitutional amendment is still on the table but needs a 2/3's majority vote in CT Congress as well as a public vote.
- CT is one of only a few states that allow a minor girl to procure an abortion without parental notification and does NOT have a ban on the murderous "partial birth abortion" even though abortion is banned after viability (very vague description of when that occurs.)
