UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

And to another He said, "Follow Me." In every moment of every day, in every circumstance and experience, God is calling us. We can easily get distracted and not hear it or simply ignore it, pretending it wasn't even heard. When we do hear it and favorably respond, there are some conditions that must be met. Jesus makes it clear that once we say yes to His invitation, we must stay focused and forge ahead. We cannot keep looking behind or worry about unfinished business. There are some tasks, and discipleship is one, that require our full devotion.

There are many "masters" vying for our attention. We need something or someone to give us direction. Human nature requires it. Our motives and actions reveal what has our allegiance. It is tempting to give ourselves to masters that lure us with intriguing promises. When given the choice between a "master" that promises worldly success, abundant wealth, status, privilege, and security versus a "master" that asks for self-sacrifice, hardship, suffering, ridicule, and death, to whom do we go? While the promise of immediate pleasure is enticing, there is always a catch. For all that secular masters can promise, they always keep us looking behind, checking on ourselves, second guessing choices, calculating options, and being slaves to excessive worry. Our guard can never come down. Only one master really promises life: Jesus Christ. Hearing His call, we either trust Him or we don't.

Saying yes to following Christ does come with a risk. But it also comes with the brightness of future hopes and dreams. There is no need to keep looking behind. Sins are forgiven and regrets serve no effective purpose. God is not there. He's moved beyond all that stuff. God is in the today and the tomorrow and what He can continually do with our daily affirmation to follow Him. All we need to do is be obedient. St. Gianna Molla is credited with saying, "The stillness of prayer is the most essential condition for fruitful action. Before all else, the disciple kneels down." Begin with prayer. We will not only hear God's call but find the courage to trust that He will guide us where we need to be. God uses us in the most ordinary of ways through the simple daily expression of our lives.

NOTES FROM FR. GOLAS

** CONSTRUCTION AT HOLY FAMILY CHURCH **

I wanted to inform you of a major project that is taking place in Fr. Kerwan Hall this summer. As of June 1st, licensed contractors started removing the asbestos floor tiles from the hall. It should take approximately one month to complete, as the planned work is to be done in three stages. The first stage is to remove the tiles from the hallway by the Religious Education office and Music room (classrooms 1&2 and 3), which requires that section of the building to be closed off from use. The entrance to that section will be closed during Stage 1. Stage 2 will encompass half of Fr. Kerwan Hall, including the kitchen and classrooms 4&5. Stage 3 will be the remainder of Fr. Kerwan Hall. This plan is designed to keep some access through the hall and to the restrooms. After Stage 1 is completed, including air tests verifying that the hall is safe to be used, this section will be open for use even without the final flooring installed. There will, however, be restricted access to some of the facilities with the new flooring being installed in July. I will keep you informed of the progress of the project, as well as, any changes to the patterns of access. I ask for your cooperation and patience as this project is being undertaken to enhance Fr. Kerwan Hall for all. Thank you!

** NEW PAROCHIAL VICAR **

I received notice from Archbishop Blair that Fr. Joseph MacNeill is being assigned as Parochial Vicar to St. Jeanne Jugan Parish, St. Martha Parish and St. Raymond Parish in Enfield from June 27, 2022 through September 18, 2022.

Fr. MacNeill was ordained in 2021 at the Cathedral of St. Joseph. Fr. Mathew and I appreciate the assistance of another priest at this time. We look forward to extending a welcome to Fr. MacNeill to our parish communities that are in the process of being merged.

** NEW MASS SCHEDULE **

I want to inform you of the new Mass Schedule that will go into effect on **July 1st, 2022**.

This schedule is based on the view that the parish has two full time priests assigned to it. There are many changes, including a decreasing number of Masses that will be offered. Four of the churches will be used for Masses as the merger process begins, with Fr. Villa saying the Masses at St. Martha Church.

I hope we keep in sight the good of the parish as a whole and the needs of the Catholic community of Enfield. Fr. Mathew and I will do our best to serve the pastoral needs of our parishioners. Through this change, we will need your cooperation and understanding. Working together with God's help, we can be a spirit and faith-filled community - like the ones we have been hearing about in our readings from Acts during this Easter season. *May God Bless!*

Make following Jesus our number one priority in life.	A To-Do list, Post-It notes, etc.	Luke 9:61-62

DISCUSSION

I don't know about you, but I would be lost without a To-Do list. Every day I have a list of all the things that I need to do. If I don't get them all done, I add them to the list for the next day. A To-Do list helps me to make sure I don't forget something that is very important. I have a sample of a To-Do list with some of the things you might put on your list: make my bed, ride my bicycle, clean my room, play with my friends, go shopping at toy store, do my homework, go to the movies, help dad mow the lawn and watch TV.

There is one problem I can see with our To-Do list. There are some things on our list that are fun and easy to do while other things might be more difficult. We might be tempted to do the fun and easy things first and leave the other things to do later if we have time. I must confess that I sometimes find myself doing that. We must remember that all of the things on our To-Do list may be good, but some are more important than others.

One day, Jesus was heading toward Jerusalem with a group of disciples. As they were walked along the road, a man said to Him, "I will follow You wherever You go." Jesus said to the man, "Foxes have dens and birds have nests, but I don't even have a place to lay My head." He wanted the man to understand that following Him might not always be fun and easy. Then Jesus turned to another man in the group and said, "Follow Me." The man answered, "First let me go and bury my Father." One of the other men with Jesus said, "Lord, I will follow You, but first let me go back and say goodbye to my family." Jesus answered him, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."

Jesus wants you and me to follow Him too. If He were here speaking to us today, He might say to us, "It's OK for you to have a To-Do list, but you need to make sure that you keep first things first, and the first thing on your list must be to follow Me." It is good for us to have a plan for our daily life. There are many good things that we do each day, but the most important thing is to follow Jesus. Let's remember to keep first things first.

Heavenly Father, we understand that it isn't always easy to follow Jesus, but nothing in life is more important. Help us to make following Jesus the number one thing in our life. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.

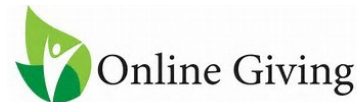
