UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Facing her 50th birthday and recently diagnosed with Type-2 Diabetes, Rebecca was at a crossroads. Realizing that she had neglected her health and fitness over the years and allowed herself to gain significant weight, she felt poorly about who she had become. While it was easier to give in to temptation and the gratification received from food, her family needed her, and she desired a long life. She had an image of the person she could become. She wanted to be more trim, focused, disciplined, and healthy. She liked what she saw in her mind and set out on a journey to create it. With great effort, she succeeded and accomplished her goals. When we have a goal ahead of us, we are more apt to do whatever is necessary to get it.

Is heaven a goal you want to achieve? Our popular images and metaphors to describe heaven can leave some people wondering if this is something they want for all eternity. Living like an angel, wearing white robes, meeting St. Peter, and reconnecting with loved ones are all welcome notions to some extent. But do they really inspire and captivate us enough to want to dramatically change how we live our lives? Heaven's reality is more profound than any human image or idea can fathom. Even though we believe in a bodily resurrection, heaven is more about attaining union with God. To achieve heaven is to attain eternal happiness and fulfill all desire. How do we awaken within us an ardent and passionate desire for heaven?

Decree merging the following parishes:
Saint Raymond of Peñafort, Saint Martha, and Saint Jeanne Jugan
of Enfield, Connecticut

On November 22, 2022, the parishes of Saint Raymond of Peñafort, Saint Martha, and Saint Jeanne Jugan of Enfield, Connecticut, will merge to form a new parish to be known as Saint Jeanne Jugan Parish, in accordance with canons 121 & 515 §2 of the Code of Canon. On October 21, 2022, Archbishop Leonard P. Blair issued a decree effecting the merger of the aforementioned parishes.

During the weekend of October 29/30, 2022, the decree will be read at all Masses, and its substance will be communicated to all parishioners by means of a notice in the weekend bulletins of Saint Raymond of Peñafort, Saint Martha, and Saint Jeanne Jugan of Enfield parishes, including the display in appropriate places at the churches, so that parishioners can read it as they enter or exit the churches. It will also be available on the Archdiocese of Hartford website, under the News/Public Notices Section, [<https://archdioceseofhartford.org/public-notices/>]. Canonical recourse may be made within the preemptory time limit of ten (10) days from the legitimate notification of the decree and in accordance with the norm of law (c. 1734 §2).

A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

At the start of a movie, there is usually a preview of upcoming movies. I write to give you a preview of the upcoming merger of the parishes of St. Raymond, St. Martha, and St. Jeanne Jugan of Enfield. Archbishop Blair announced this in his letter of April 22, 2022. The Archdiocese is implementing the "municipal model" to bring the three parishes into one parish with multiple churches. The decree will be announced publicly this weekend by various means. The effect of the decree will mean one parish in church and civil law. Church law (canon law) sees a parish as a community of Catholics of a certain area and the church as a place for worship. In the past, Church and parish were considered the same. On **November 22, 2022**, the merger decree will go into effect. St. Jeanne Jugan Parish will be the Catholic parish of Enfield with five churches, although one church is not in use.

The merger will take time to fully implement. As decisions are made concerning the merger, timely communication will help to bring us together as a parish. Things will continue as they are for now. The parish councils will continue to function for now until new by-laws can be drafted to address the new parish situation. For now, the existing St. Jeanne Jugan parish will need to include representation from the other two churches. I will be establishing a new finance council with representatives from all of the churches. I hope and pray we will continue to be united in our faith and love for the Lord. On behalf of Fr. Mathew, Fr. Villa, Deacon Vince Motto, Deacon Paul Robert, and Deacon Michael Torres, I want to thank you for your prayerful and kind support. In these challenging times, we trust the Lord is with us and guiding us to a stronger and brighter future.

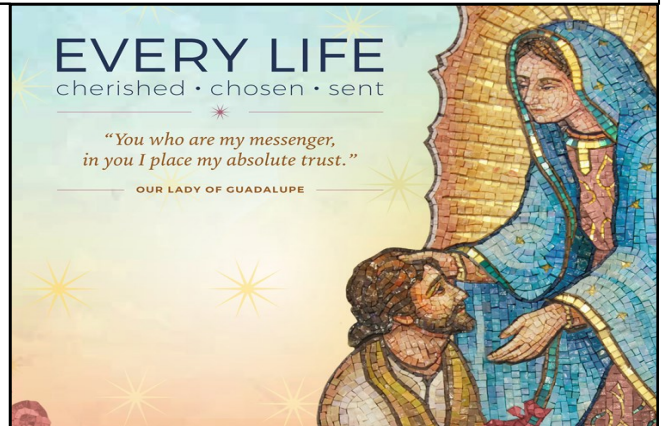

THEME	OBJECT	SCRIPTURE
Heaven will be amazing.	A book of jokes and riddles.	Luke 20:27-40

DISCUSSION

You know what a riddle is, don't you? It is a word puzzle -- a question that makes you think. Sometimes riddles are funny. I'm sure you have probably heard this one. "Why did the chicken cross the road?" The answer is, "To get to the other side." Here are a few of my favorite riddles. Q: Mary's father has 4 children; three are named Nana, Nene, and Nini. What is the fourth child's name? A: Mary! (You may have to explain!) Q: How many months have 28 days? A: All of them! (Some may have 30 or 31, but all have 28!) Q: What is full of holes but can still hold water? A: A sponge! (You might show them one!)

Riddles have been around since the time of Jesus. Maybe longer than that. One day, Jesus was approached by a group of Sadducees - religious leaders who did not believe in the resurrection or the happiness of heaven.

The Sadducees were trying to trick Jesus into agreeing that there was no resurrection. They asked Him to answer this riddle: "The law of Moses says that if a man dies, leaving a wife but no children, his brother should marry the widow and have a child who will carry on the brother's name. Well, suppose there were seven brothers. The oldest one married and then died without children. So the second brother married the widow, but he also died. Then the third brother married her. This continued until all seven brothers had married the same woman. Finally, the woman also died. So tell us, whose wife will she be after the resurrection since all seven were married to her!"

My, that is a tricky riddle, isn't it? Listen to Jesus' answer.

Jesus said, "Marriage is for people here on earth. But in the age to come, those who are raised from the dead will not marry or be married. Not only that, but they will never die again. They will live forever as the children of God."

After Jesus answered their riddle so wisely, no one dared to ask Him any more questions.

Now, you and I know that Jesus promised us that if we love Him and trust in Him, we will live forever in heaven with Him. Isn't it sad that some people do not believe there is a resurrection and eternal life in heaven? Oh, that reminds me of one more riddle!

Q. Why were the people in today's Bible lesson called Sadducees? A. Since they didn't believe in the resurrection or the happiness of heaven, they were "Sad, you see!"

Dear Father, we are happy today that You have promised us eternal life in heaven. Thank You that heaven is going to be amazing! In Jesus' name, Amen.

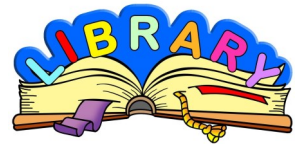

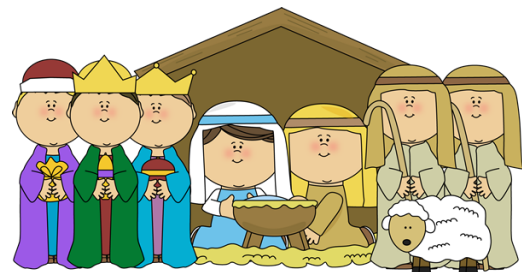

HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the [Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults](#). This document is also available online at www.archdioceseofhartford.org. The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.

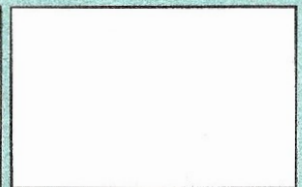

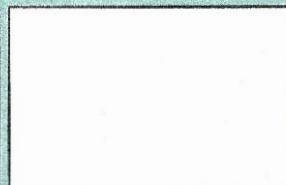

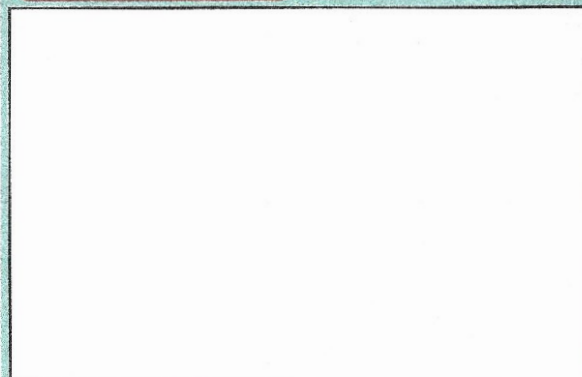
