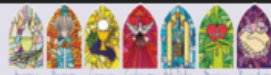

# COME TO GOD FREELY

## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

It's not unreasonable to think that if God wanted to make a statement He could do so in a very dramatic way. After all, He spoke through a burning bush that didn't actually burn, parted the Red Sea, sent manna to the Israelites from the sky, cured lepers, healed the sick and cast out demons. All of that is pretty dramatic stuff, and they made statements! Now, Jesus hangs dying on a cross. He has been referred to as a king. Considering all of the miracles Jesus did in His short time on earth, isn't one more in order? If Jesus came down off the cross, defied death, and parted the waters of suffering and death, onlookers, believers and unbelievers alike, would take notice. It would prove who God is and show us what God wants us to do. Or would it?

Great spiritual masters remind us not to focus on miracles or consolations received from God. They can distract us. Doing anything other than what Jesus did would distract humanity as well, misplacing our focus. It's not about a miracle, at least not the dramatic kind people are eager to see. It's about something more profound. It all goes back to where it began for the earthly Jesus. God becomes one with humanity in Jesus Christ. All that goes into being human is holy and blessed, and that becomes a place where God is born, again and again. God, through Jesus, tells us to hold firm to all of the experiences of being human, the joys and the wonders, the disappointments and the failures.

God's lesson is found in Jesus' vulnerability. It is only when we are vulnerable that we learn how to love. When Jesus breathed his last, God's unconditional and tender love was realized. Jesus always had a soft spot for the weak, lost, vulnerable, and broken. God wants us to come to Him freely, not because we have witnessed some fantastic display of prowess. God desires that we find Him through who we are, as our hearts and souls direct. This will mean that our love is authentic as it will be born of the heartache, pain, and turmoil that are a part of life. The fragments of our lives need to be made whole. Our fragmented king, Jesus Christ, is the only one who can help put the pieces together.

## DISCUSSION

Today I'm going to tell you about a Backward King and I need your help. When I stop and point at you, you'll say, "That's backward!" Ready?

A long time ago, there lived a King. He was no ordinary king. He was a Backward King. He was different from other kings because He did everything backward from the way other kings did them. From the very day He was born, you could tell that this King was going to be different. Most kings are usually born in a palace, but this King was born in a stable surrounded by donkeys, sheep and cows. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") It wasn't a very big beginning for a king. In fact, very few people even knew that a King had been born. Only a handful of shepherds and three wise men got the word that a king had been born. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") As the infant king grew into a man, He continued to be different from other kings. While most kings spent all of their time building up riches of silver, gold, and jewels, this King owned nothing at all. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") And while most kings surrounded themselves with servants, He chose to be a servant. He could often be found helping others. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") As time went on, people became very unhappy with their King because He just didn't act the way they thought a king should act. Instead of riding into town on a big white horse the way other kings usually did, their King rode into town on the back of a donkey. Was that any way for a king to act? (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") And the people He chose to be His friends! His closest friends were a bunch of smelly fishermen and He could often be seen visiting with the poor and eating with sinners. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") Finally the people decided that they had put up with this King long enough. If He couldn't act the way a king should act, then they didn't want Him to be their king any more. They made a plan to have Him arrested and thrown into prison. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") Their plan worked. When the day came for His trial, the King stood before the people. Instead of shouting "Hail to the King, Long live the King!" they shouted, "Crucify Him! He is not our King! Crucify Him!" (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!") So they crucified the King. They nailed Him to a cross; they put a crown made of thorns on His head; they poked Him with sharp sticks and made fun of Him. What a way for a king to die! After He was crucified, they took His body and put it in a borrowed tomb. (Stop and point at kids to say, "That's backward!")

Wait, that isn't the end of the story. Remember...this Backward King was different! This King rose from the grave to live forever. Now, instead of being the Backward King, He is the Forever King. He is the King to anyone who chooses Him to be their King. Oh, there are still some people who call Him "King Backward," but those who know Him don't call Him that ... they call him King Jesus!

Jesus wants to be your king too, and if you choose Him to be your king, you will live happily forever, and forever after!

*Dear Jesus, today we crown You King and Lord of our life. In Jesus' name, Amen.*

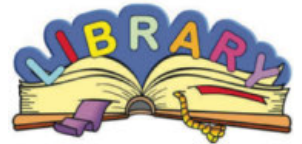
