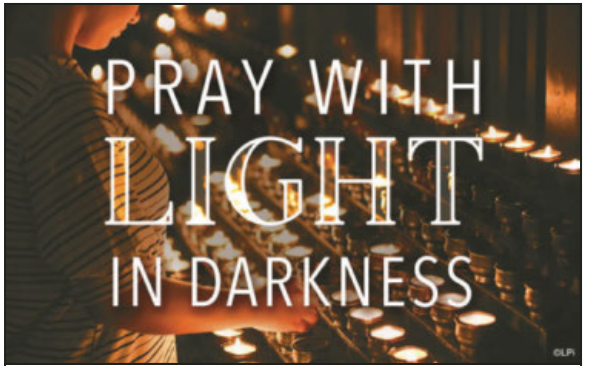

## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

When I was a young seminarian, I asked a wise old priest how to pray better. He said simply, "Don't lie when you pray." He helped me to see how much energy I waste in trying to appear acceptable to God when I pray. For me, prayer was showing off for God and hiding what was ugly.

It's stunning that the Gospel of Matthew tells us of Jesus, "He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulon and Naphtali..." This isn't just the Lord's relocation up north. It's His moving into places of shame and defeat. This region was where the enemy invasion of Israel began centuries before. Jesus left the comfortable confines of Nazareth and sought out a place of darkness, not to bring shame, but to announce the dawning of his light.

When we pray, we usually prefer Jesus to stay put in our little Nazareths — where we feel comfortable, successful, and in control. But He moves. He re-locates into the Zebulons and Naphtalis of our shame, embarrassment, fear, and sense of being defeated. The question for us is: will we allow Him to take up residence in those places in our prayer time? Will we talk to Him honestly about our places of darkness? If we do, we're no longer lying when we pray.

## NOTES FROM FR. GOLAS

From Fr. John Golas,

I have important news about the merger of the Catholic parishes in Enfield. I met recently with Attorney Karen Casey of Cooney, Scully, and Dowling to sign the papers petitioning the Secretary of State of Connecticut to merge St. Martha Parish and St. Raymond Parish into St. Jeanne Jugan Parish. This will create one Parish corporation for Enfield. Our parish is already established in Church law.

With the merger, there will be the need for new trustees, and a new finance council. Our existing parish council will also need to be restructured to include all four Churches. I have asked Susan McMurray and John Lynch to serve as the trustees of the parish. I want to thank those who served in this role for the Churches in the past. I am grateful for Sue and John to take on this responsibility. The new finance council will continue to be chaired by Bill Cotter. He is very familiar with the parish finances and the Archdiocesan guidelines and requirements. I have asked Alva Torre, Charlie Palomba, Clem Dumont, Tom Tubman, Joan Ferris, and Mike Booth to serve on the finance council. I appreciate their willingness to serve on this council. I am grateful for the service of the finance councils of the Churches in the past. As priest, I value this support.

The parish council will need to be restructured with the writing of new bylaws. This is a process that takes time. In the meantime, I will appoint members of St. Martha Church and St. Raymond Churches on an interim basis to serve on the St. Jeanne Jugan Parish Council until a new council can be organized. The existing St. Raymond Finance Council and Parish Council will continue to function as a sub-committee of the parish with its sole responsibility to supervise the final disposition of St. Adalbert Church and its sacred items. This sub-committee will make recommendations to me and the parish and finance councils about the way to proceed. Deacon Paul Robert is the chair of this sub-committee. I appreciate and value the work of the parish council, past and present. I am blessed to have Fr. Mathew, Deacons Vince, Paul, Mike and a very capable staff to help out. James Marco will be ordained to the diaconate this June from the parish. I have already requested his assignment to our parish. I will continue to communicate any important developments and please continue to pray for St. Jeanne Jugan Parish.

Telling others about Jesus.	A rod and reel or other fishing equipment.	Matthew 4:18-23

## DISCUSSION

Do you enjoy fishing? Have you ever caught a fish?

Fishing is a great sport, and if you have ever been fishing and have caught a fish, you know that there's a great feeling of excitement when you catch a fish. One of the things that makes fishing such a great sport is that it doesn't matter if you're young or old...you can still be good at fishing.

What does it take to be good at catching fish? First of all, you need to be properly equipped. You can't just get a piece of string, put a hook on it, and tie it on the end of a stick and expect to catch many fish, can you? No! If you're serious about fishing, you'll make sure you have all the right equipment. You'll want a nice rod and reel like this one I have this morning.

The next thing you need to know is that you have to go where the fish are to catch fish!

Finally, if you want to be good at fishing, you must be patient. Sometimes the fish just aren't biting. You have to wait patiently.

Our Bible lesson today has something to do with fishing. One day, Jesus was walking along the seashore when He saw two brothers named Peter and Andrew. Jesus knew they made their living by fishing, so He called out to them, "Follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" Do you know what they did? They laid down their fishing nets and followed Jesus.

Jesus wants you and me to fish for people, too. That means that Jesus wants us to tell others about what He has done for us and what He wants to do for them. Fishing for people is a lot like fishing for fish.

First, we need to be properly equipped. We need to know what the Bible teaches and learn how to share it with others.

Next, we go out where the people are and tell them about Jesus.

Finally, we must be patient.

If we will do these things, we can really become fishers of people like Jesus wants us to be. If you think there is a great feeling of excitement in catching a fish, just imagine how exciting it must be to bring someone to Jesus!

*Dear Jesus, help us become fishers of people. Help us tell others what You have done for us and what You want to do for them. In Jesus' name, amen.*

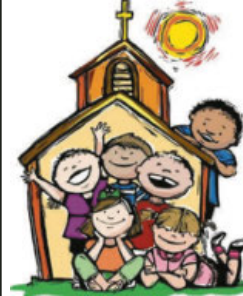

## Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

January 22

January 22 has been designated by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal as "a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion." Life is at the heart of the Gospel – a beautiful gift from God. When that gift is destroyed rather than treasured, a violent act is committed not just against God, but all humanity. As Pope John Paul II remarked, "The Gospel of God's love for man, the Gospel of the dignity of the person, and the Gospel of life are a single and indivisible Gospel."

## EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP

So the NFL season is almost over. Only the Super Bowl remains. For some fans, the season is already over since their team is now sitting at home. It is amazing the allegiance some people have to their teams. Some people bleed Green Bay green and yellow or believe the only team is supposedly America's team, the Dallas Cowboys. Of course, if you are reading this outside the States, perhaps you live and breathe a team like the New Zealand All Blacks or the Calgary Flames.

In the early church, people took their allegiance to certain leaders to an extreme. Paul chastised them for thinking that the baptism of one community or the teachings of a certain leader were superior to the anything else in this new movement of Jesus followers. He reminded them that there is to be no division in Christ and that all things flow from Christ, not from the leaders in the community. Those who follow Jesus are one body of Christ: a place where there is no room for competition or condescension.

Sometimes our stewardship efforts in a parish become all about the parish. We seek to get people to do more stuff and give more money and we lose sight of why we live a stewardship way of life in the first place: Jesus. It is wonderful to watch our parishes grow into more vibrant communities that lead people to Jesus. We should rejoice to be in such a parish family. But one day there will be no parishes and those who have received His gifts freely and have followed Him will live with Christ as one forever. In your stewardship, always keep Jesus as *the main thing*.

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the [Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults](#). This document is also available online at [www.archdioceseofhartford.org](http://www.archdioceseofhartford.org). The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

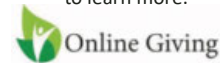
