## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

In my parents' bedroom there were on the wall two photos of my mom and dad from their early adulthoods. The photo of my mother entranced me when I was a boy. I loved looking at it, even though I saw her in daily life. Something about that picture captured her perfectly. It was an image of the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength that enveloped me from the start of my life. It was an icon of the woman who fed, taught, and encouraged me. I felt a deep pride that I came from such beauty.

The beatitudes of Jesus are a kind of self-portrait. But it is a strange picture. At first, the blessings of being poor, mourning, and hungering and thirsting for righteousness may seem bizarre or, worse, a religious delusion. Who wants to look like that? But if we look again, we begin to see the characteristics of Jesus' form. He becomes poor and fills it with His riches for us, He weeps and mourns for us, and fills it with His joy, He hungers and thirsts for us to be righteous, and so satisfies us. And so on. It's the way He appears on the cross.

Perhaps we should put on our bedroom room walls the words of the beatitudes next to a crucifix of the Lord Jesus. Then we can do what the beatitudes are designed for, to gaze at the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength of the one who is our origin, and who is with us every day. And little by little, we'll start to look like him.

## NOTES FROM FR. GOLAS

From Fr. John Golas,

I have important news about the merger of the Catholic parishes in Enfield. I met recently with Attorney Karen Casey of Cooney, Scully, and Dowling to sign the papers petitioning the Secretary of State of Connecticut to merge St. Martha Parish and St. Raymond Parish into St. Jeanne Jugan Parish. This will create one Parish corporation for Enfield. Our parish is already established in Church law.

With the merger, there will be the need for new trustees, and a new finance council. Our existing parish council will also need to be restructured to include all four Churches. I have asked Susan McMurray and John Lynch to serve as the trustees of the parish. I want to thank those who served in this role for the Churches in the past. I am grateful for Sue and John to take on this responsibility. The new finance council will continue to be chaired by Bill Cotter. He is very familiar with the parish finances and the Archdiocesan guidelines and requirements. I have asked Alva Torre, Charlie Palomba, Clem Dumont, Tom Tubman, Joan Ferris, and Mike Booth to serve on the finance council. I appreciate their willingness to serve on this council. I am grateful for the service of the finance councils of the Churches in the past. As priest, I value this support.

The parish council will need to be restructured with the writing of new bylaws. This is a process that takes time. In the meantime, I will appoint members of St. Martha Church and St. Raymond Churches on an interim basis to serve on the St. Jeanne Jugan Parish Council until a new council can be organized. The existing St. Raymond Finance Council and Parish Council will continue to function as a sub-committee of the parish with its sole responsibility to supervise the final disposition of St. Adalbert Church and its sacred items. This sub-committee will make recommendations to me and the parish and finance councils about the way to proceed. Deacon Paul Robert is the chair of this sub-committee. I appreciate and value the work of the parish council, past and present. I am blessed to have Fr. Mathew, Deacons Vince, Paul, Mike and a very capable staff to help out. James Marco will be ordained to the diaconate this June from the parish. I have already requested his assignment to our parish. I will continue to communicate any important developments and please continue to pray for St. Jeanne Jugan Parish.

St. Bernard School is looking to fill a **Long-Term Substitute** position, for a maternity leave. The position would need to be filled through the end of the school year in June 2023.

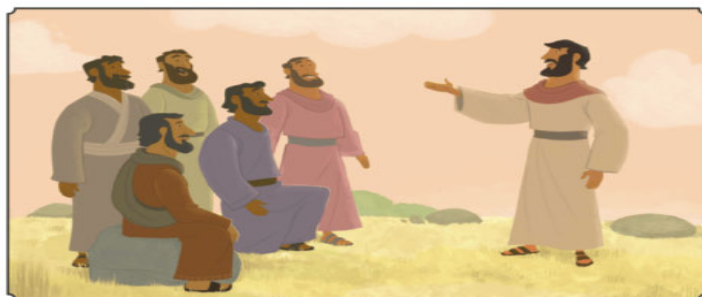

Jesus gave us the recipe for happiness - the Beatitudes.	The ingredients for making trail mix.	Matthew 5:1-12

## DISCUSSION

Today, we are going to fix a tasty snack. Oh boy, that sounds like fun. The first thing we need is a recipe. You know what a recipe is, don't you? A recipe is a set of instructions, including a list of all the ingredients. I have a recipe to make a delicious and healthy trail mix. And here are the trail mix ingredients we need and a bowl to mix it in. (Show the items.)

Can you help me make this trail mix? Let's read the recipe to know how to make it. First, we will add some Chex Mix and M&Ms. (Hand the bags to children to pour into the bowl.) Let's see, next we add some pretzel sticks and then some yogurt-covered raisins. (Hand the bags to children to pour into the bowl.)

We're not done! We still have two more ingredients for our trail mix. Let's add the Cheez Its and the Honeycomb cereal. (Hand the bags to children to pour into the bowl.)

Well, the trail mix is all finished and I need someone to stir it. (Choose a child to gently stir the trail mix.) So now we have a tasty snack we can enjoy later. (Set the trail mix aside.)

Did you know that Jesus gave us a recipe for living a happy life? In the book of Matthew, the Bible says, "Now when Jesus saw the crowds, He went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to Him, and He began to teach them." He taught them a lesson we call "The Beatitudes." Each one of the beatitudes starts with the words, "Blessed are they..." Some translations of the Bible use the word happy instead of blessed. So this is Jesus' recipe for us to be happy.

I like that the word "beatitudes" has two parts to it: be and attitude. The Beatitudes are ways that we can be and attitudes we can have. Let's look at a few of these be-attitudes.

Jesus said to... Be merciful to people... To be kind when they are hurting...Be peacemakers when people are fighting...Have an attitude of pure thoughts...Have an attitude of wanting to do right. Jesus also said that when we are sad, God comforts us and then we are happy.

I like that Jesus gave us a recipe for how to be and what kind of attitudes to have. And Jesus says that we will be happy if we follow His recipe.

*Dear God, thank You for the beatitudes. Please help us follow Your recipe for a happy and blessed life. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.*

This document is also available online at [www.archdioceseofhartford.org](http://www.archdioceseofhartford.org). The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.
