UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

Of all the things Jesus says which seem totally bat-crazy, this one might take the cake: "But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you." An enemy is someone who desires the destruction of you, your projects, or those you care about. To love and pray for them is to want their health, strength, and flourishing. But if they thrive, they are more likely to hurt you and others. So, aren't you indirectly willing your own destruction, or that of your friends? If you doubt that this problem is embedded in this teaching, when was the last time you actually prayed honestly for the people you really hate?

How can we solve this riddle so we might actually live this command? Recall that enemy-love is the surest sign that you love someone with God's love, and not with indirect egotism. After all, if my love for my enemy ends up hurting me or my loved ones, it can't be for me. Enemy-love costs more because there are no tit-for-tats. No reciprocity — just love poured out, and often pain in return. That's why it is so precious and rare. "What is unusual about that?" asks the Lord about love for our friends. Jesus wants us to experience the unusual love which only comes from Him.

When Jesus was being killed on the cross, He was loving His executioners. In fact, He was holding them in being as they nailed him to the cross. He loved those who were spiritually piercing His Mother's heart, while they were doing it. And when He rose from the dead, He showed us that this kind of love is always worth it. It's stronger than death. Real love is unusual. — *Father John Muir*

NOTES FROM FR. GOLAS

From Fr. John Golas,

I have important news about the merger of the Catholic parishes in Enfield. I met recently with Attorney Karen Casey of Cooney, Scully, and Dowling to sign the papers petitioning the Secretary of State of Connecticut to merge St. Martha Parish and St. Raymond Parish into St. Jeanne Jugan Parish. This will create one Parish corporation for Enfield. Our parish is already established in Church law.

With the merger, there will be the need for new trustees, and a new finance council. Our existing parish council will also need to be restructured to include all four Churches. I have asked Susan McMurray and John Lynch to serve as the trustees of the parish. I want to thank those who served in this role for the Churches in the past. I am grateful for Sue and John to take on this responsibility. The new finance council will continue to be chaired by Bill Cotter. He is very familiar with the parish finances and the Archdiocesan guidelines and requirements. I have asked Alva Torre, Charlie Palomba, Clem Dumont, Tom Tubman, Joan Ferris, and Mike Booth to serve on the finance council. I appreciate their willingness to serve on this council. I am grateful for the service of the finance councils of the Churches in the past. As priest, I value this support.

The parish council will need to be restructured with the writing of new bylaws. This is a process that takes time. In the meantime, I will appoint members of St. Martha Church and St. Raymond Churches on an interim basis to serve on the St. Jeanne Jugan Parish Council until a new council can be organized. The existing St. Raymond Finance Council and Parish Council will continue to function as a sub-committee of the parish with its sole responsibility to supervise the final disposition of St. Adalbert Church and its sacred items. This sub-committee will make recommendations to me and the parish and finance councils about the way to proceed. Deacon Paul Robert is the chair of this sub-committee. I appreciate and value the work of the parish council, past and present. I am blessed to have Fr. Mathew, Deacons Vince, Paul, Mike and a very capable staff to help out. James Marco will be ordained to the diaconate this June from the parish. I have already requested his assignment to our parish. I will continue to communicate any important developments and please continue to pray for St. Jeanne Jugan Parish.

Love one another -- even your enemies.	A large heart cut out of red poster board.	Matthew 5:43-44

DISCUSSION

What do you think of when you see a heart? (Hold up the heart.) Most of us would probably say that when we see a heart, we think of love. Who do you love? Do you love your parents? Do you love your brother or sister? How about your best friend? Do you love your teacher? It is easy to love these people, because they love us too.

Are there any boys or girls that are mean to you at recess? Has anyone ever said something about you that was not true? Do you love those boys and girls? Should we really be expected to love people who are mean to us, treat us badly, and say ugly things about us? Well, let's listen to what Jesus told us to do.

One day Jesus was teaching out on a hillside. We call His lesson that day "The Sermon on the Mount." In His sermon, Jesus said some things that really surprised His listeners. "You have heard that you should love your neighbors and hate your enemies," Jesus said. "But I say, love your enemies -- and if someone does mean and hateful things to you, pray them."

Why should we love our enemies? Jesus said that when we love our enemies, we are acting like children of God. If we only love those who love us, will God reward us for that? If we are only kind to our friends, what is so great about that? Everybody does that!

It isn't always easy to love your enemies, but there are some good reasons for doing it.

It demonstrate the love of God to others.

It sets a good example for others to follow.

It turns enemies into friends.

Father, it is easy to love those who love us. Help us to love our enemies so that they might know that we are Your children. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.

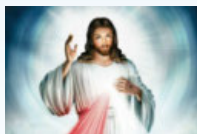

HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the [Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults](#). This document is also available online at www.archdioceseofhartford.org. The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Incidents involving sexual abuse of minors (persons under the age of 18) should be reported to:

Incidents involving sexual abuse of vulnerable adults aged 18 – 59 should be reported to:
Connecticut Department of Developmental Services – AID Division for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities | 1-844-878-8923

Department of Social Services for the Elderly | 1-888-385-4225

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.

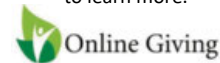
