# GIVE WHAT THE MASTER ASKS

## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

What's your car? Let's say it's a fancy silver Toyota. Now imagine you're having lunch in a restaurant and suddenly see two men outside attempting to steal it. You run outside and confront them. They respond, "The master has need of it." How do you respond? Would you just let them take it, and leave you without a car? I don't think I would.

Yet that is precisely what the owners of the colt on Palm Sunday do. Stunningly, and perhaps a little comically, Jesus instructs two of His disciples to commandeer a colt for Him to ride. And when they hear the disciples say, "**The master has need of it,**" they let them take it. Of course, Jesus knew they'd let it go. He gave them the grace to let go of what is rightfully theirs. The result? That colt became perhaps the most famous and important animal ever. The beast plays a role in the redemption of the world.

As Holy Week begins, Jesus perhaps will send people to you to ask for something valuable to you. Perhaps it's your car. More likely it's something like your attention, time, or energy. It's natural to resist at first. We've got things to do, after all. But if the interruption is from Jesus Himself, listen to that voice which calmly says, "**The master has need of it.**" And simply let it go. You'll be amazed what the master will do with it.

Betraying Christ.	None needed.	Matthew 26: 21-25

## DISCUSSION

How many of you like to watch cop shows like Law and Order? How many have seen Hill Street Blues? How about Dragnet? (I'm not going back any farther; I'll give away my age!) On these shows, did anybody get arrested? I've seen shows where someone would rat out their friend or their husband or wife to keep from going to jail, haven't you?

Judas, Peter, and the other disciples did something like that to Jesus. You see, the Sanhedrin, and others, wanted to kill Jesus and arrest His disciples, too. Now, we all know Jesus wasn't a bad guy; He never did anything wrong, but they all betrayed Him.

Judas sold information to the Sanhedrin for 30 pieces of silver. Because of Judas's betrayal, Jesus was found and arrested. This eventually led to His death on the Cross.

The other disciples betrayed Jesus when they didn't keep watch while Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane that night.

Peter even betrayed Him 3 times when he denied knowing Him after Jesus was arrested so he wouldn't get arrested too.

What did Judas, Peter, and the other disciples have in common (besides betraying Jesus)? They all said, "Not me, Lord."

In Matthew 26:21 (during the Passover meal) Jesus said to the twelve, 'I tell you the truth, one of you will betray Me.' In v:22 'They were very sad and began to say to Him one after the other, "Surely not I, Lord?"' (also Mark 14:18-19)

Judas said in Matthew 26:25, "Surely not I, Rabbi?" (also Mark 14:19)

The Bible tells us in v35: 'Peter declared, "Even if I have to die with You, I will never disown You." And all the other disciples said the same.' (also Mark 14:31)

With the exception of Judas, Peter and the other disciples didn't betray Jesus on purpose. They had no deliberate intention to, but they were afraid there was the possibility.

Some of you are probably thinking, "Not me. I would never do that." The truth is we betray Jesus all of the time. I'm sure we don't set out to. It's not intentional. Yet we betray Jesus when we say we are devoted to Him but don't live like it; when we 'talk the talk' but don't 'walk the walk'; when we gossip, tell 'little white lies'..... whenever we don't stand up for Jesus.

*Prayer: Dear Jesus, we all know we betray You in some way every day and we are ashamed of our weakness. Help us to be strong and to live our lives each day so that we can say, "Not me, Lord. Not today." Amen.*

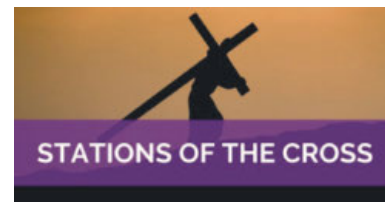

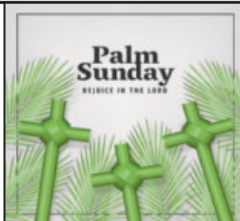

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the [Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults](#). This document is also available online at [www.archdioceseofhartford.org](http://www.archdioceseofhartford.org). The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.

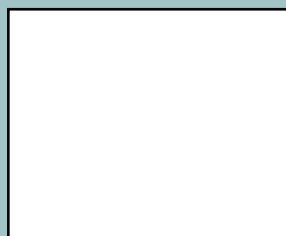
