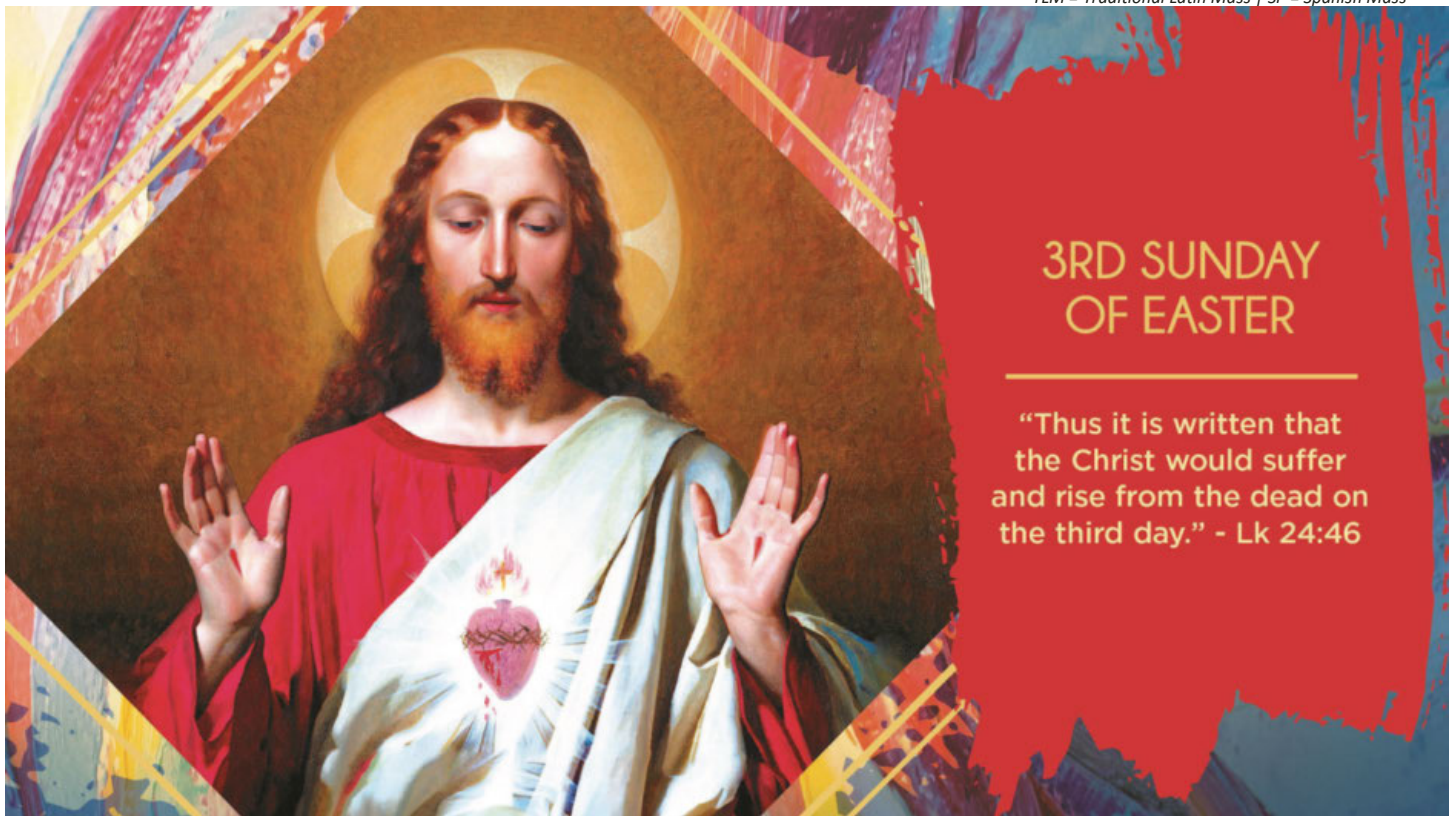

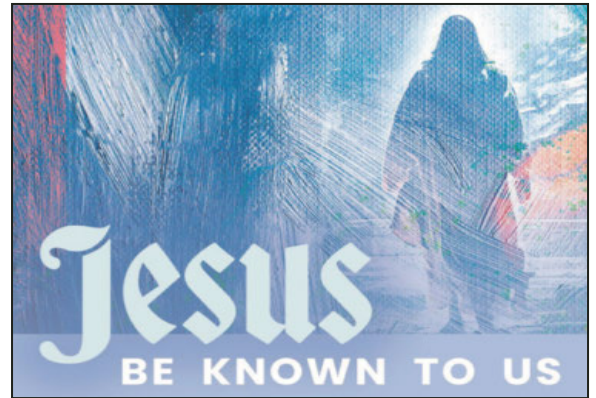

## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

When I was a kid, a friend at my home parish told me, "If you get to Mass by the Gospel reading, it counts!" As a lifelong late-arriver, it's something I have told myself many times, especially in my earlier years as a Catholic. If the "it counts" is justifiable on a pathetically minimal scale of liturgical legalism, then the Gospel reading today shows how insanely wrong-headed it is, and how helpful it is to re-think the Mass in its light.

The famous "Road to Emmaus" story recounts, on that first Sunday of the Resurrection, the basic two-fold structure of the Mass: *Word*, followed by *Eucharist*. Jesus spends a significant period of time with two dismayed disciples, as he connects a wide swath of the Hebrew scriptures with his own suffering, death, and resurrection. They would later report that this Liturgy of the Word touched their hearts with an inexplicable fire. This Word-induced flame alone is what leads the two disciples to discover Jesus' presence in the "breaking of the bread."

With this in mind, how can we possibly think that the Liturgy of the Word is unnecessary or incidental? The two disciples needed the Scriptures explained to them in order to experience Jesus alive in the eucharistic breaking of bread. Sure, we say, but they had the Risen Jesus. But that's precisely the point: Jesus is risen and accompanies us in both parts of the Mass. Imagine how much our experience of Jesus in the Eucharist would deepen if we (preachers and listeners) took even more seriously that Jesus himself sets our hearts ablaze with his Word *so that* we know him in the Eucharist. That Word-induced fire counts, too!

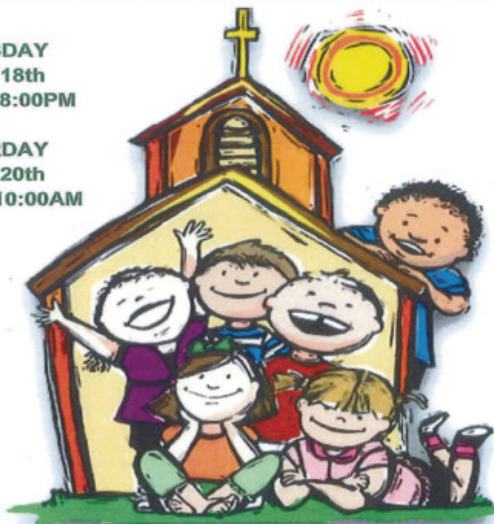

Having open minds and hearts to sharing the Gospel.	A hidden word puzzle.	Luke 24:45-47

## DISCUSSION

Do you enjoy puzzles? I like puzzles, especially word puzzles. Word jumbles are my favorites. That is a puzzle where the letters of a word are all mixed up and you have to figure out what the word is. Sometimes it is easy to figure the word out. Other times I will look and look and can't figure out what the word is. Then, all of a sudden, it seems my mind is opened and the word is clear to me.

We have a word puzzle for you today. The letters are not mixed up. The word is just hard to see. I am going to hold it up and show it to you. If you see the word, don't say what it is until everyone has had time to figure out what the word is. (Hold up the puzzle and wait for a short time.) If you can see the word, raise your hand. Who can tell us what the word is? That's right, the answer is Jesus!

This puzzle reminds me of something that happened in our Bible lesson today. The Bible tells us that Jesus appeared to some of his disciples and said, "Peace be with you." The disciples were afraid and weren't sure what they were seeing. They thought they were seeing a ghost.

Seeing that they were afraid, Jesus said to them, "Why are you troubled? Why do you have doubts? Look at my hands and my feet. Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones like I have."

Jesus could see that they still weren't convinced, so He asked them, "Do you have anything to eat?" They gave Him a piece of fish and He ate it as they watched.

Then Jesus opened their minds so that they could understand the Scriptures. He taught them saying, "It was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer, die, and be raised from the dead on the third day. It was written so that this message would be told to every nation, beginning in Jerusalem: 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.' You are witnesses of all these things."

As Jesus opened the minds of his disciples, let us pray that He will open our hearts and minds to spread the Good News to everyone we know that Jesus died, was buried, and rose again so that we could have forgiveness of sin.

*Heavenly Father, open our minds to understand Your Word, open our hearts to live Your Word, open our lips to share the Word with others. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.*

## DECREE FROM REVEREND CHRISTOPHER M. FORD, J.C.L., CHANCELLOR

### The relegation to profane but not sordid use of Saint Adalbert Church in Enfield, Connecticut

On April 22, 2024, the church of Saint Adalbert, located at 90 Alden Avenue in Enfield, Connecticut, will be relegated to profane but not sordid use in accordance with canon 1222 §2. On March 15, 2024, Archbishop Leonard P. Blair issued a decree effecting the relegation that Saint Adalbert Church is no longer a sacred place for divine worship.

During the weekend of March 23/24, 2024, the decree will be read at all Masses, and its substance will be communicated to all parishioners by means of a notice in the weekend bulletin of Saint Jeanne Jugan Parish, including the display in appropriate places at all the churches, so that parishioners can read it as they enter or exit the churches. It will also be available on the Archdiocese of Hartford website, under the News/Public Notices Section, (<https://archdioceseofhartford.org/public-notices/>). Canonical recourse may be made within the preceptory time limit of ten (10) business days from the legitimate notification of the decree and in accordance with the norm of law (c.1734 §2).

## UPDATE: THE SALE OF ST. ADALBERT CHURCH

The Archdiocese has approved the sale of St. Adalbert Church and adjacent properties and is preparing the necessary canonical and legal paperwork to finalize the sale on **Monday, April 29th, 2024**. The buyer is a Church community currently located in Wethersfield. Under canon law, the Church will return to non-sacred status on **Monday, April 22nd, 2024**, and all sacred goods will be removed to other churches or cemeteries within the Parish, or consigned to other Parishes/Churches in need. A closing Mass will be held at St. Adalbert Church on **Sunday, April 21st, 2024 at 2:00PM**.

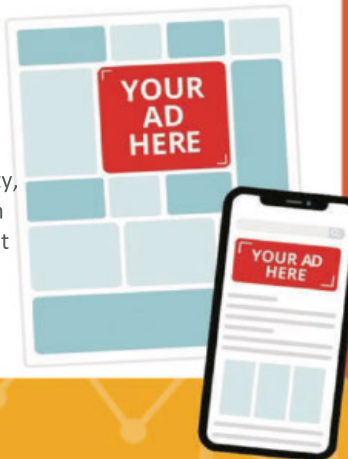

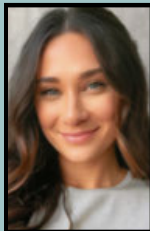

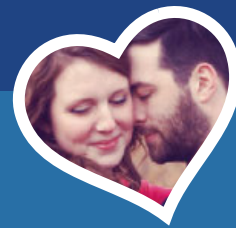
