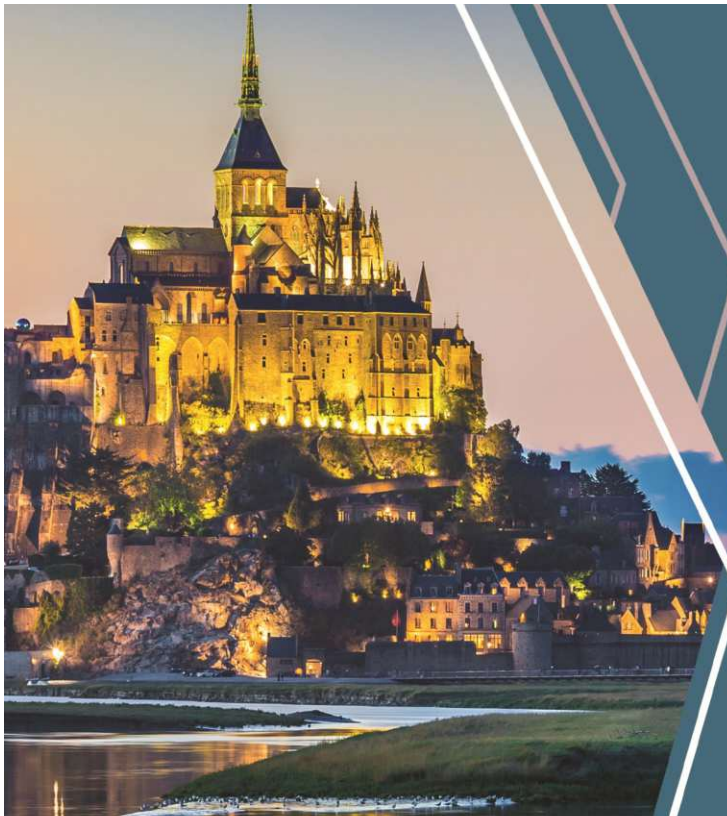

# THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP



## UNDERSTANDING THE SCRIPTURE

I recently learned why zebras have stripes. Scientists used to think it was for camouflage, but new research suggests something more interesting: the stripes help zebras blend in with one another. When a predator looks at a herd, the overlapping stripes make it hard to single out one animal. But if a researcher spray-paints a dot on just one zebra, predators lock on it and eventually attack. The lesson? In the wild, blending in is protection. Standing out can be dangerous.

Human beings are not so different. Most of us would rather blend in than stand out, especially when it comes to our faith. We know that giving bold witness to Jesus — through our words, values, or public choices — can make us targets for criticism, isolation, or judgment. That's why Jesus' words in today's Gospel are so challenging: **"You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden"** (Matthew 5:14).

A city on a hill draws attention. It also draws fire. But that's part of the cost of discipleship. Jesus doesn't call us to be tribal or boastful. He calls us to stand in the open with humble confidence, so that people might see our good deeds and glorify our Father in heaven. Today, let's ask for the courage not just to believe in Christ, but to be seen believing in him.

## DISCUSSION

I hope you all know the song, "This Little Light of Mine" because I want you to help me sing that song this morning. While we sing it, I'm going to hold up this light and let it shine all around. (Sing the song, but the light doesn't shine.)

What's wrong? My light isn't shining. (Someone will probably notice that it isn't plugged in.) Oh, here's the problem, my light wasn't plugged in. (Plug in the light.)

Let's try it again. (Sing the song, but the light still doesn't shine.) Well, I wonder what the problem is now? (Someone may suggest that the light wasn't turned on.) Oh, here's the problem, my light wasn't turned on. Let's try it one more time. (Sing the song again and this time the light will shine.)

The Bible tells us that we should let our light shine. Before our light will shine, we must be plugged in and turned on. We must be plugged into God's power supply.

How do you think we might "plug in" to God's power supply? (It's okay if kids don't know.)

When we believe in Jesus, it's like we're plugged into God's power supply. We can also plug into God's power supply by coming to church to learn about God and to worship Him. And when we read the Bible together, we are plugged into God's power supply.

What's a way you plug in that makes you feel close to God?

When we are plugged in, it helps us be close to God. And it also makes us shine like lights.

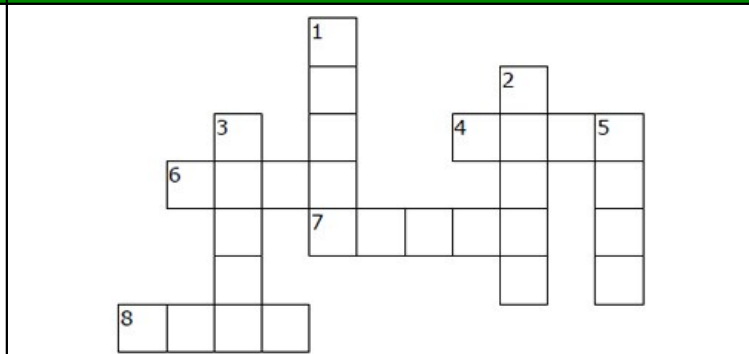

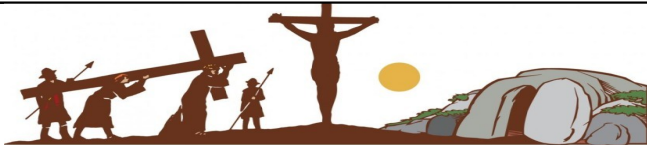

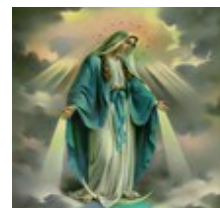

The bow came up high and she slid under. The last thing I saw, the Four Chaplains were up there praying for the safety of the men. They had done everything they could. I did not see them again. They themselves did not have a chance without their life jackets."
